# DEFINITIONS:

## EARLE SCHOOL DISTRICT

**CTE Concentrator** -A student who has completed one foundational CTE credit and one additional CTE credit for a total of two CTE credits within the same approved CTE program of study.

Any two levels must sum to two (2) credits within a program of study. Concentrators must have 1.0 credit in Level 1. Level 1 includes the foundational courses. Levels progress in specificity as required (Section 3(41)(D-E)).

**Non-Concentrator** -All other students. Non-concentrators may include students who have completed one or more CTE credits that were not within the same program of study or in the progressive levels of specificity. Non-concentrators may include students who have never completed a CTE credit.

### Who is included in these reports?

Students included in these reports are Grades 9 – 12 students actively enrolled as indicated in 2020-21 school year SIS Cycle 7 who have earned a concentration in one or more program of study. Credits may be earned starting in Grade 7 through Grade 12. An example for 2021 concentrators is provided below.



### Data Definitions:

- The performance measure data in this report are from the 2021-22 school year except for postsecondary placement which is a lagged indicator. The students included in the postsecondary placement performance measure exited high school in the 2020-21 school year.
- Consortium membership and single LEA status are based on the 2021-22 school year.
- Students are included in the consortium, district, and school aggregations based on their district and school LEAs indicated in 2021-22 SIS cycle 7 and based on consortium membership and single LEA status for 2021-22.

# GRADUATION PERFORMANCE MEASURES

## [1S1, 1S2]

### EARLE SCHOOL DISTRICT

Performance Measures for Graduation Rate consist of a Four-Year Adjusted Cohort Graduation Rate (1S1) and a Five-Year Extended Adjusted Cohort Graduation Rate (1S2). In both cases, only concentrators are included in the measure and concentrators are only counted once.

#### Four-Year Adjusted Cohort Graduation Rate [1S1]

- Numerator: The percentage of CTE concentrators who graduate high school, as measured by the four-year adjusted cohort graduation rate (defined in section 8101 of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965).
- Denominator: Number of CTE concentrators who, in the reporting year, were included in the State's computation of its graduation rate as defined in the State's Consolidated Accountability Plan pursuant to Section 1111(b)(2) of the ESSA.

**Formula:**

2022 Four-Year Adjusted cohort Graduation Rate

$$\frac{\text{CTE Concentrators in the 2022 Four – Year Adjusted Cohort who were Actual Graduates}}{\text{CTE Concentrators in the 2022 Four – Year Adjusted Cohort who were Expected to Graduate}}$$

#### Five-Year Extended Adjusted Cohort Graduation Rate [1S2]

- Numerator: The number of CTE concentrators who graduate high school, as measured by extended-year adjusted cohort graduation rate defined in such section 8101.
- Denominator: Number of CTE concentrators who, in the reporting year, were included in the State's computation of its extended-year cohort graduation rate as defined in the State's Consolidated Accountability Plan pursuant to Section 1111(b)(2) of the ESEA.

**Formula:**

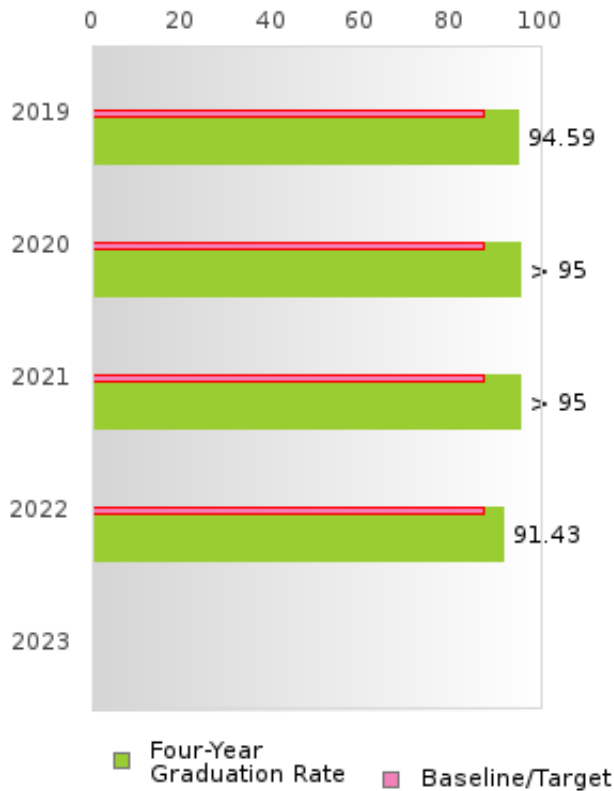

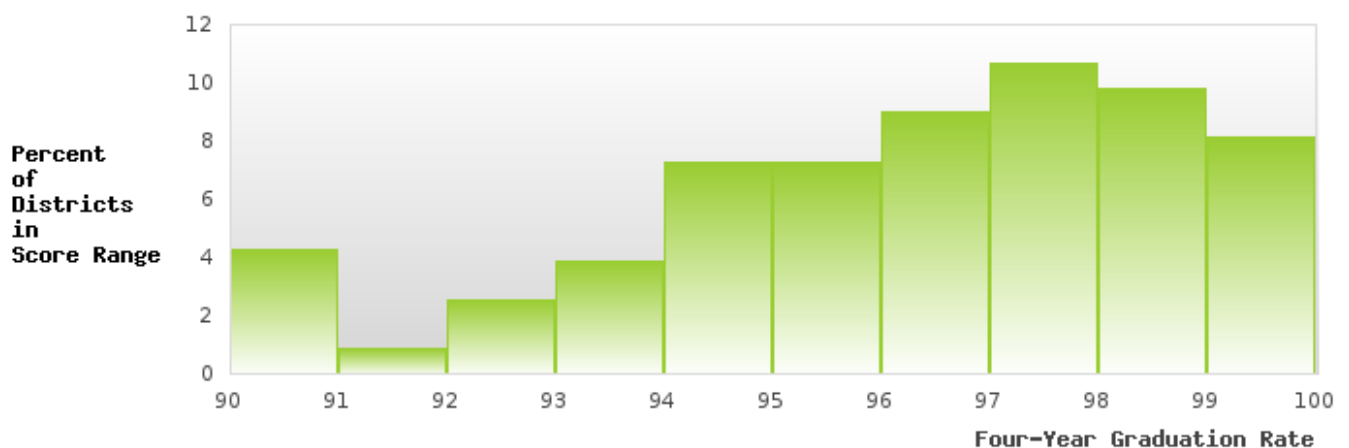

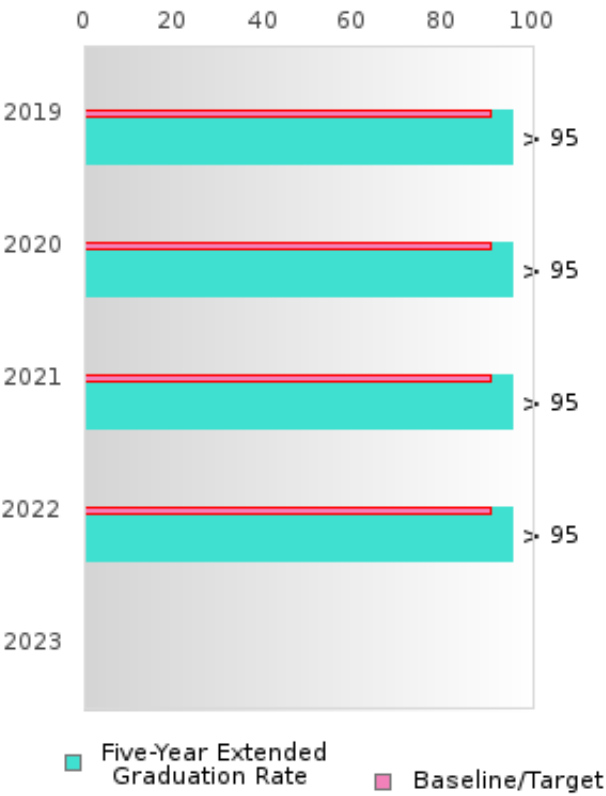
### DISTRIBUTION OF DISTRICT FOUR-YEAR ADJUSTED COHORT GRADUATION RATES

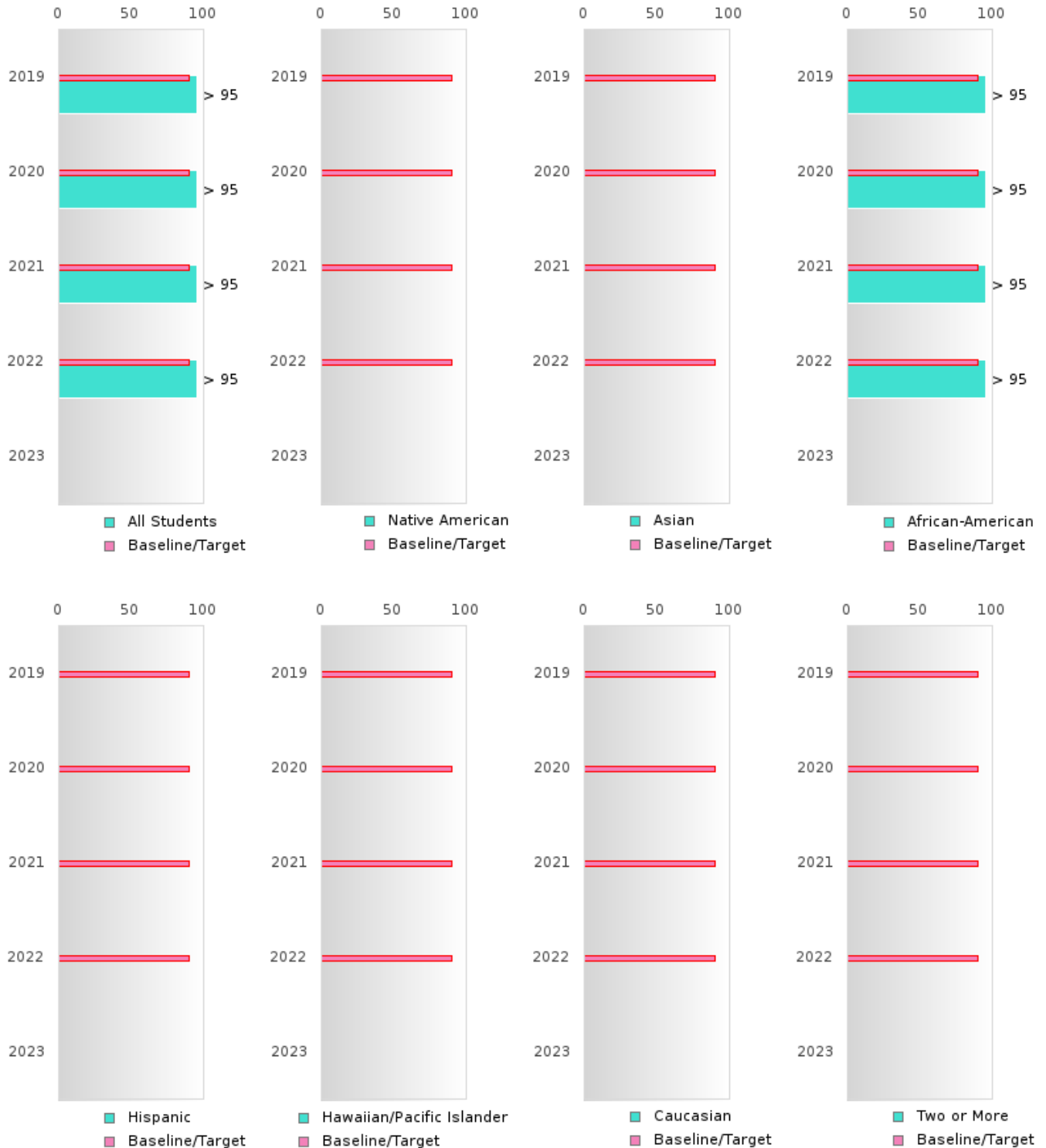
### FOUR-YEAR ADJUSTED COHORT GRADUATION RATE BY RACE/ETHNICITY

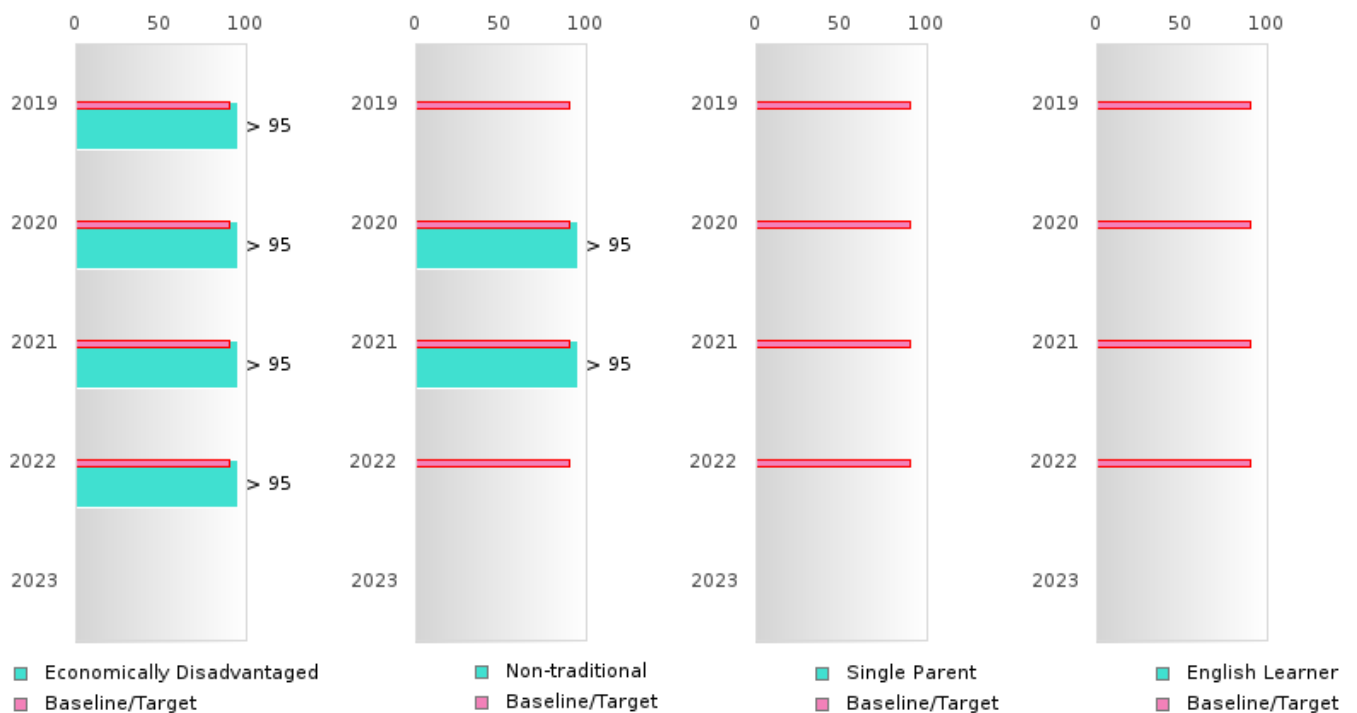
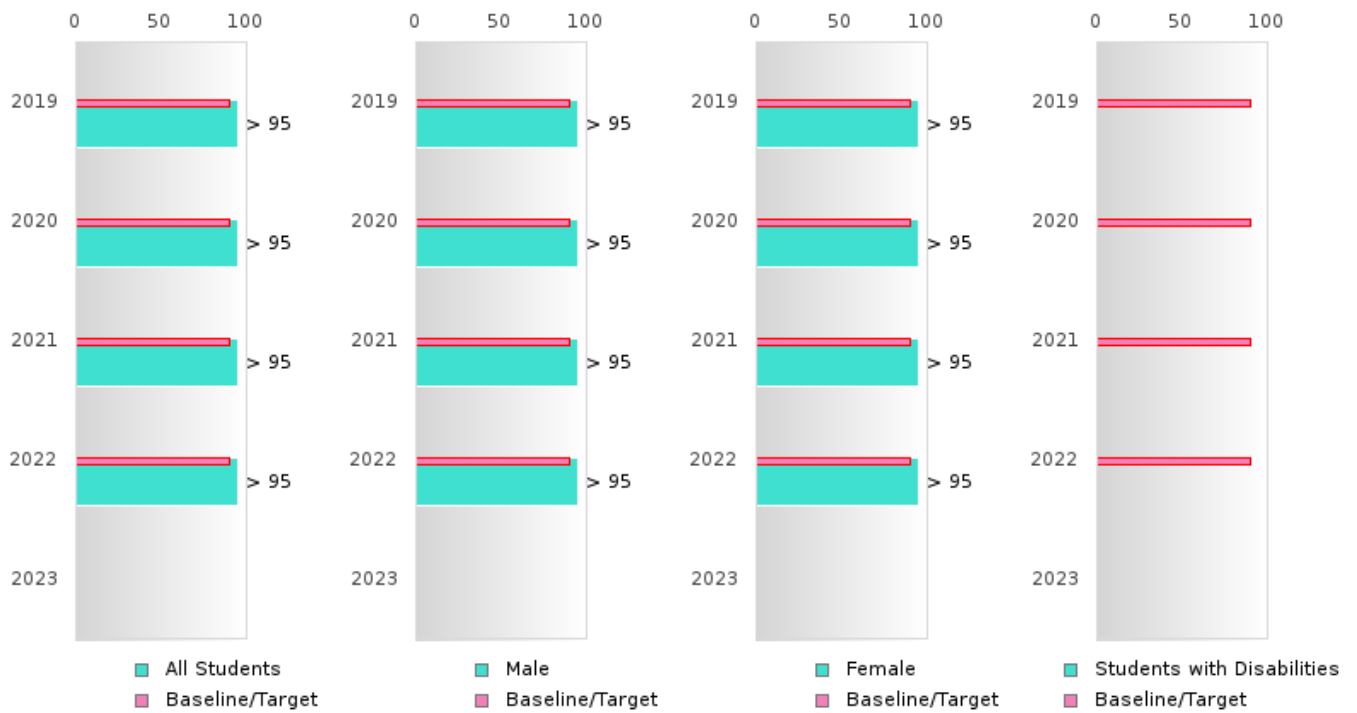
### CONSORTIUM FOUR-YEAR ADJUSTED COHORT GRADUATION RATE BY SPECIAL POPULATION

### CONSORTIUM FIVE-YEAR EXTENDED ADJUSTED COHORT GRADUATION RATE BY SPECIAL POPULATION

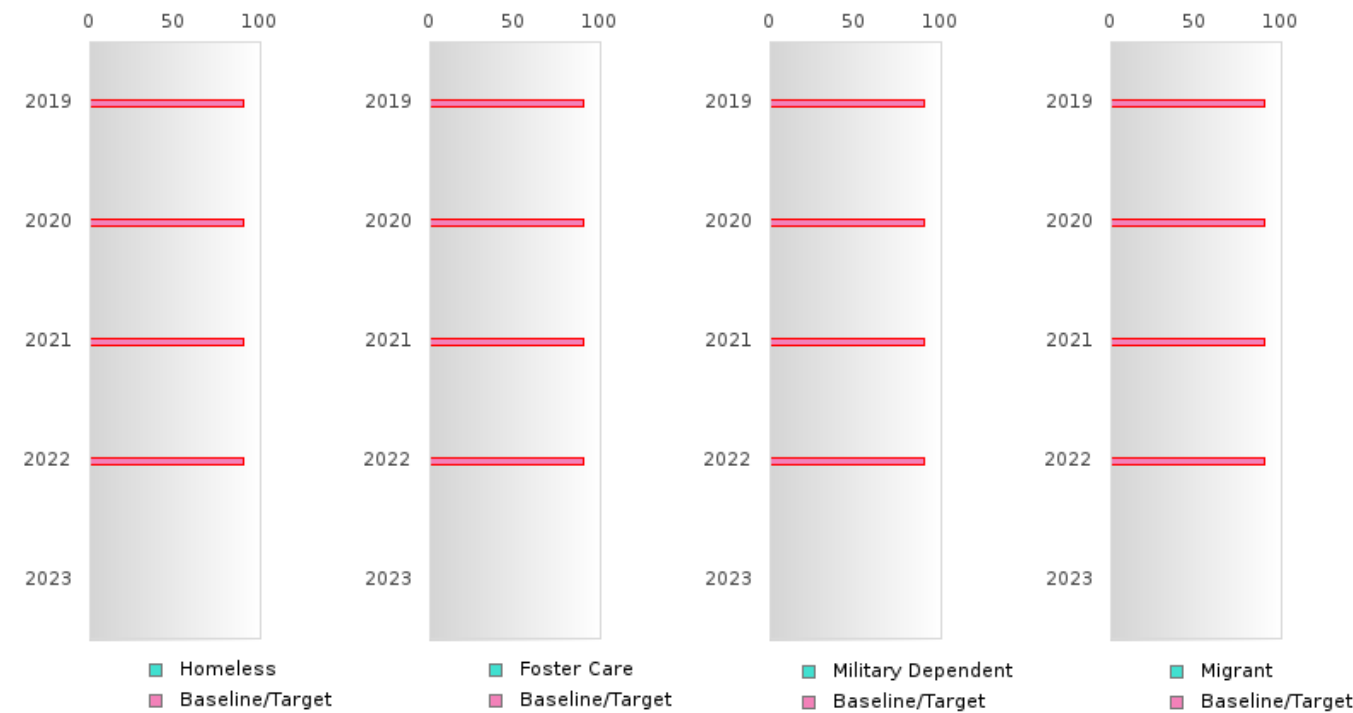

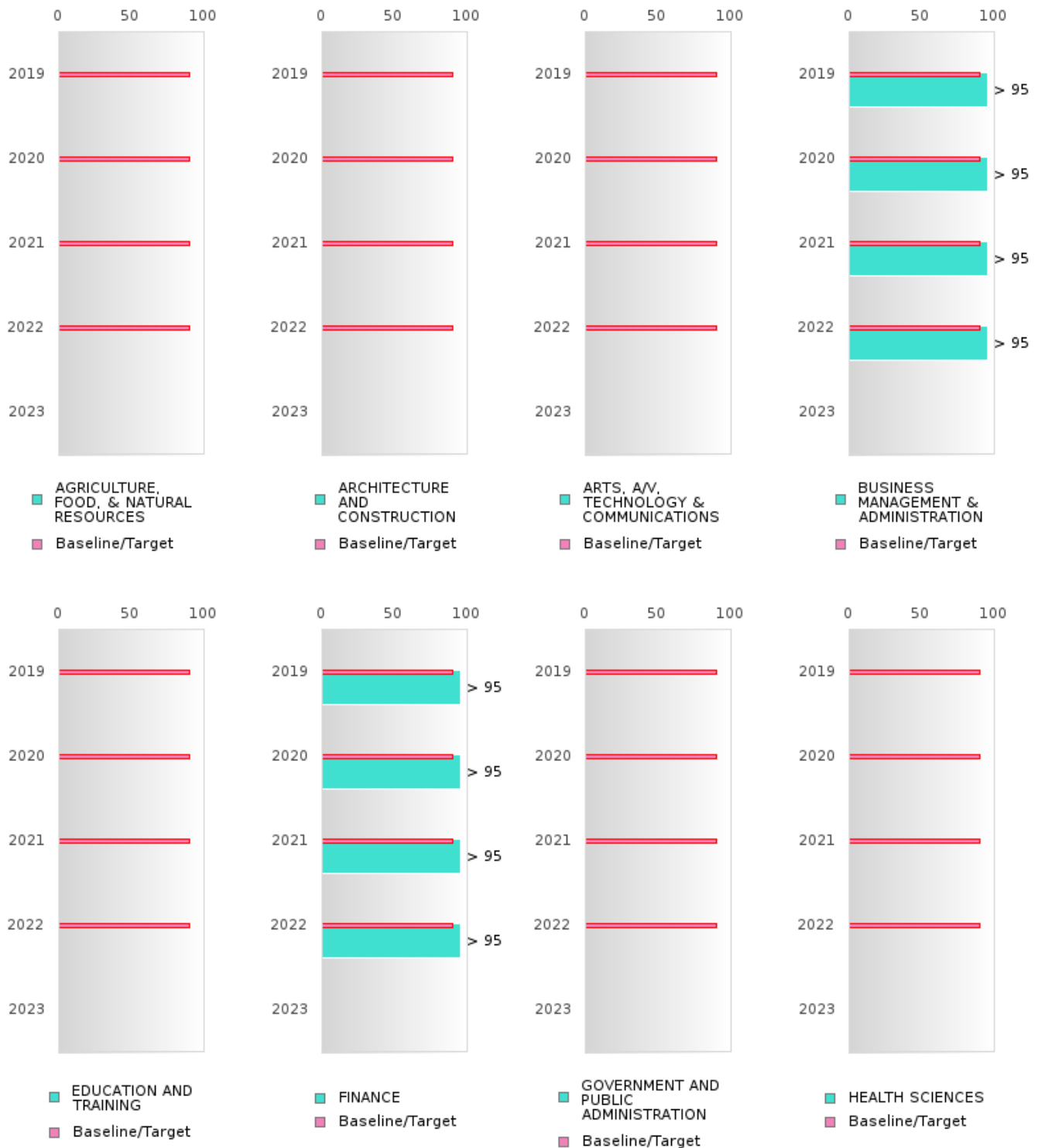
### CONSORTIUM FOUR-YEAR ADJUSTED COHORT GRADUATION RATE BY CLUSTER

# ACADEMIC PERFORMANCE MEASURES

## [2S1, 2S2, 2S3]

### EARLE SCHOOL DISTRICT

The Academic Proficiency Performance Measures (Reading/Language Arts [1S1]; Mathematics [1S2]; Science [1S3]) in Arkansas's approved Perkins V plan are designed to align with the achievement and growth measures in Arkansas's approved ESSA plan. This alignment provides schools with a unified focus on increased rigor and relevance in student learning opportunities within a student-focused learning system to improve academic proficiency and increase students' readiness for college, career, and community engagement.

The Academic Performance Measures include concentrators that are full academic year students: students who are continuously enrolled in a particular school on or before October 1 through the date of the first data pull for the regular or alternate assessment.

#### Assessments Included:

Act Aspire (Grades 9 - 10) • Dynamic Learning Maps (Grades 9 - 10) • ACT (Grades 11 -12 [3-yr best])

#### Academic Proficiency Score Calculation:

- Weighted Achievement (Grades 9 – 12) and Value-Added Growth Scores (Grades 9 -10) Included in Score
- Reading/Language Arts, Mathematics, and Science calculated separately
- Calculated for all schools with Grades 9, 10, 11, and/or 12

For students in Grades 9 or 10 with ACT Aspire Scores:

- In Need of Support (0 points), Close (0.5 point), Ready (1.0 point), Exceeds (1.0 or 1.25 points\*) for ACT Aspire

For students in Grades 9 or 10 with Dynamic Learning Maps Performance Levels:

- Performance Levels 1 (0 points), 2 (0.5 point), 3 (1.0 point), 4 (1.0 or 1.25 points\*)

\*Points for Exceeding depend on the number of students in the lowest readiness level compared to the number in the Exceeding level.

For students in Grades 11 or 12 with ACT Scores:

- ACT Score < 17 (0 points);  $17 \leq \text{ACT score} < 19$  (0.5 points);  $19 \leq \text{ACT Score} < \text{ACT College Readiness Benchmark}$  (1.0 point); ACT Score  $\geq$  College Readiness Benchmark (1.0 to 1.25 points)

For students in Grades 11 or 12 without ACT Scores:

- Last ACT Aspire score available from Grades 9 or 10.

ACT College Readiness Benchmark Scores are Reading = 22; Mathematics = 22; Science = 23

*ELA Weighted Achievement Score*  $\times$  (0.50) + *ELA Mean Value – Added Growth Score*  $\times$  (0.50)

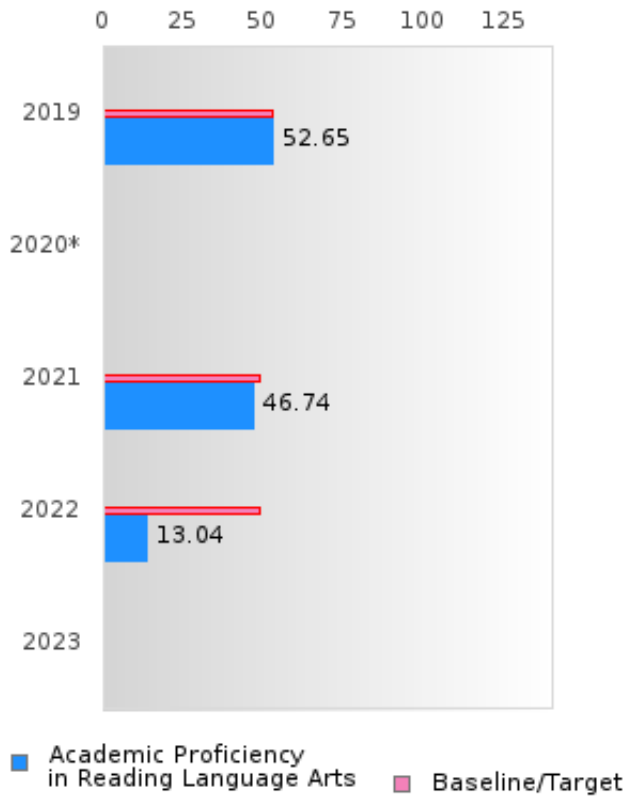

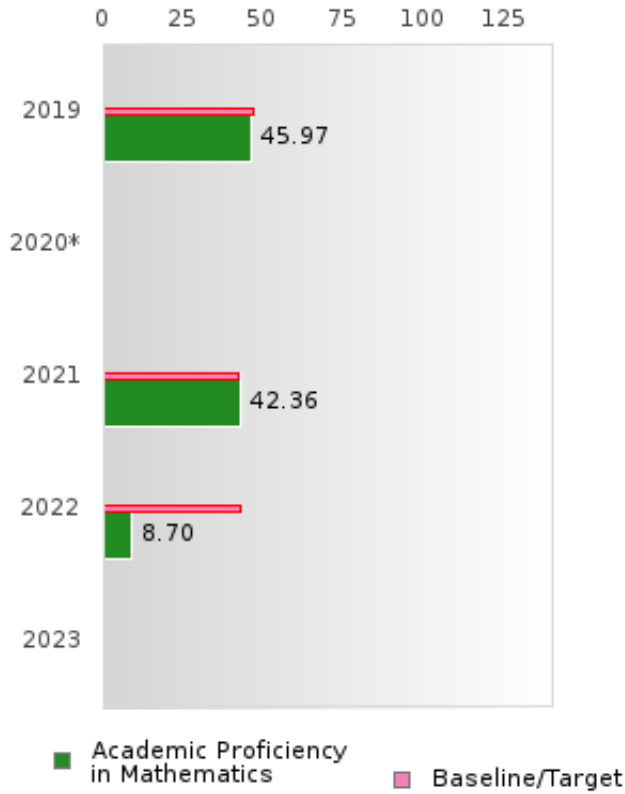
### DISTRIBUTION OF DISTRICT SCORES FOR ACADEMIC PROFICIENCY IN READING LANGUAGE ARTS

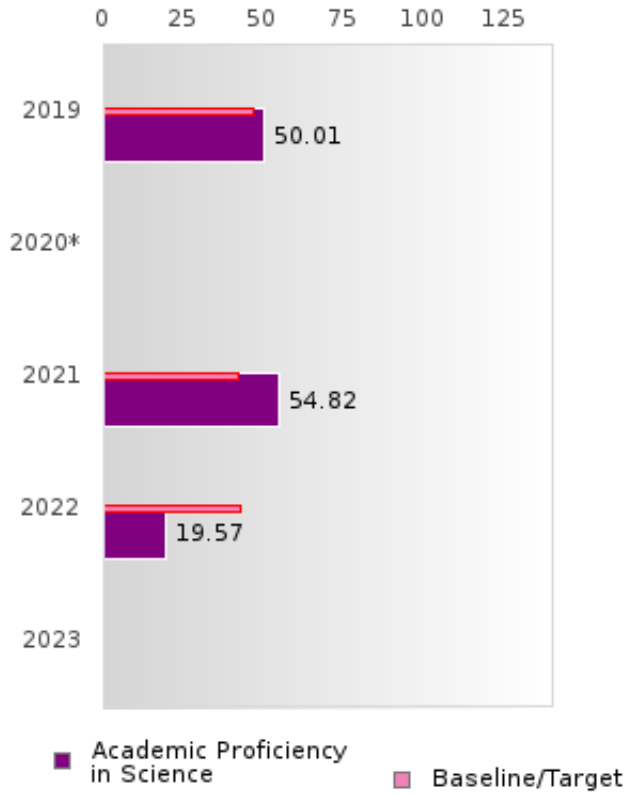
### DISTRIBUTION OF DISTRICT SCORES FOR ACADEMIC PROFICIENCY IN MATHEMATICS

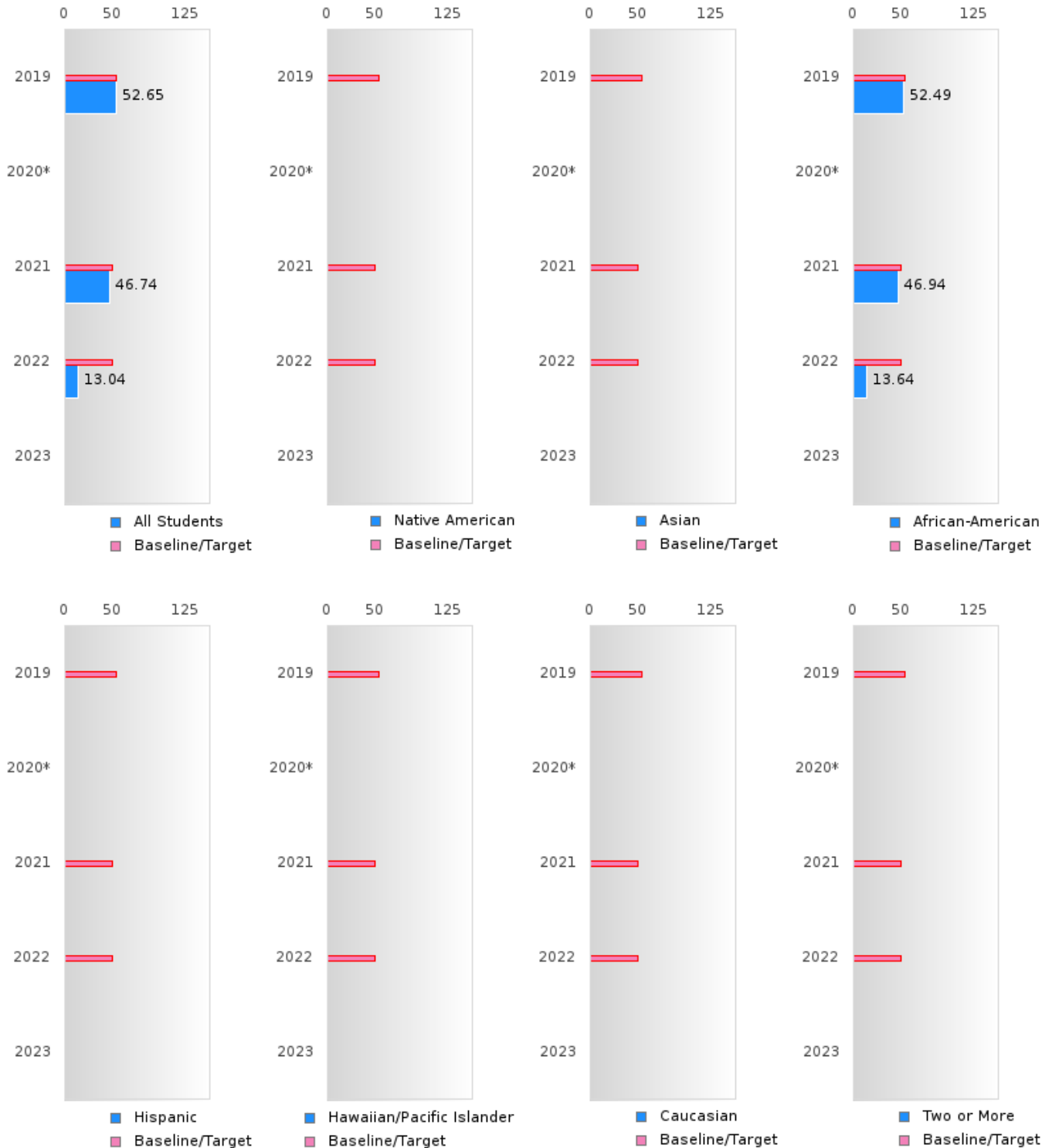
### DISTRIBUTION OF DISTRICT SCORES FOR ACADEMIC PROFICIENCY IN SCIENCE

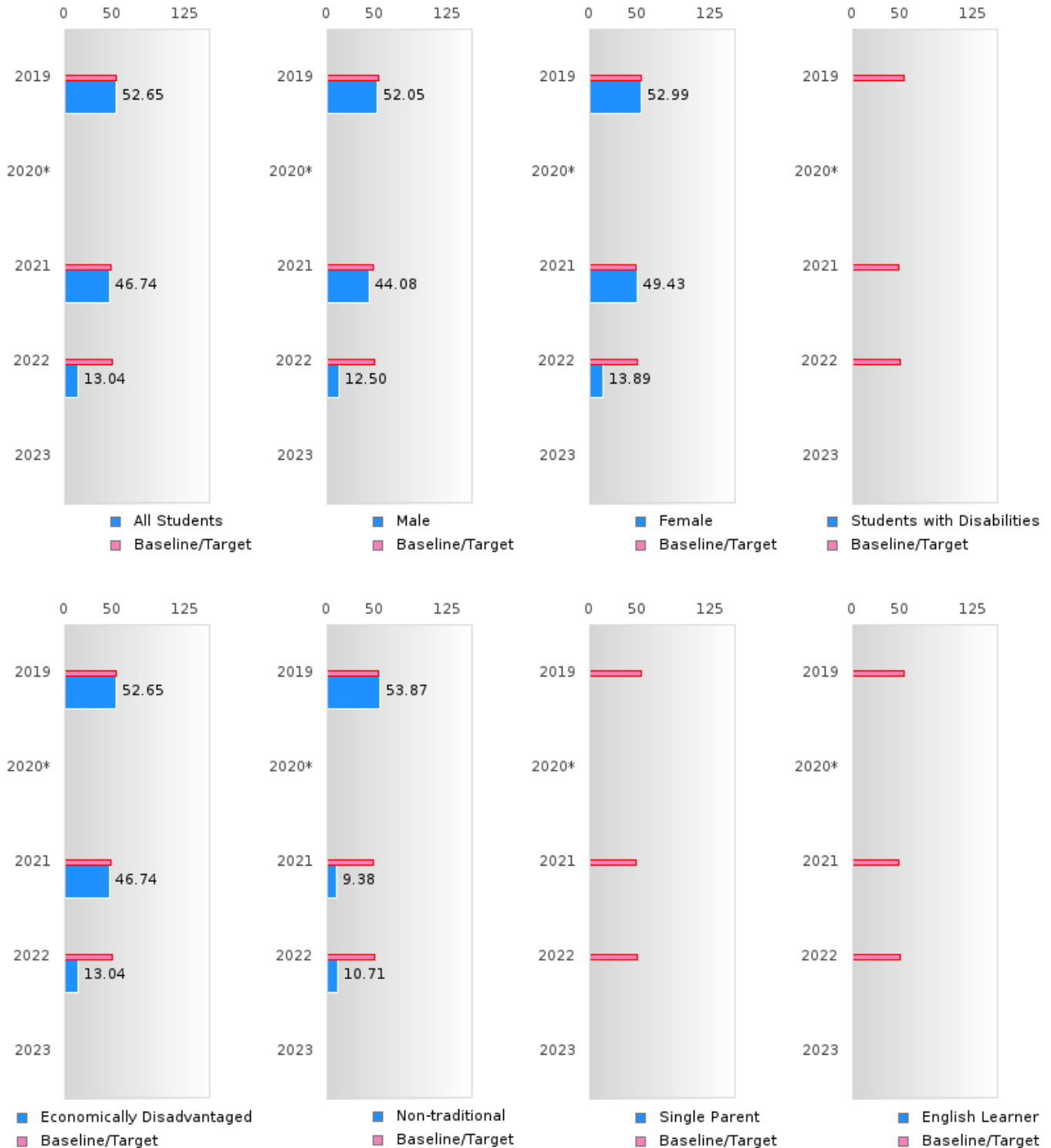

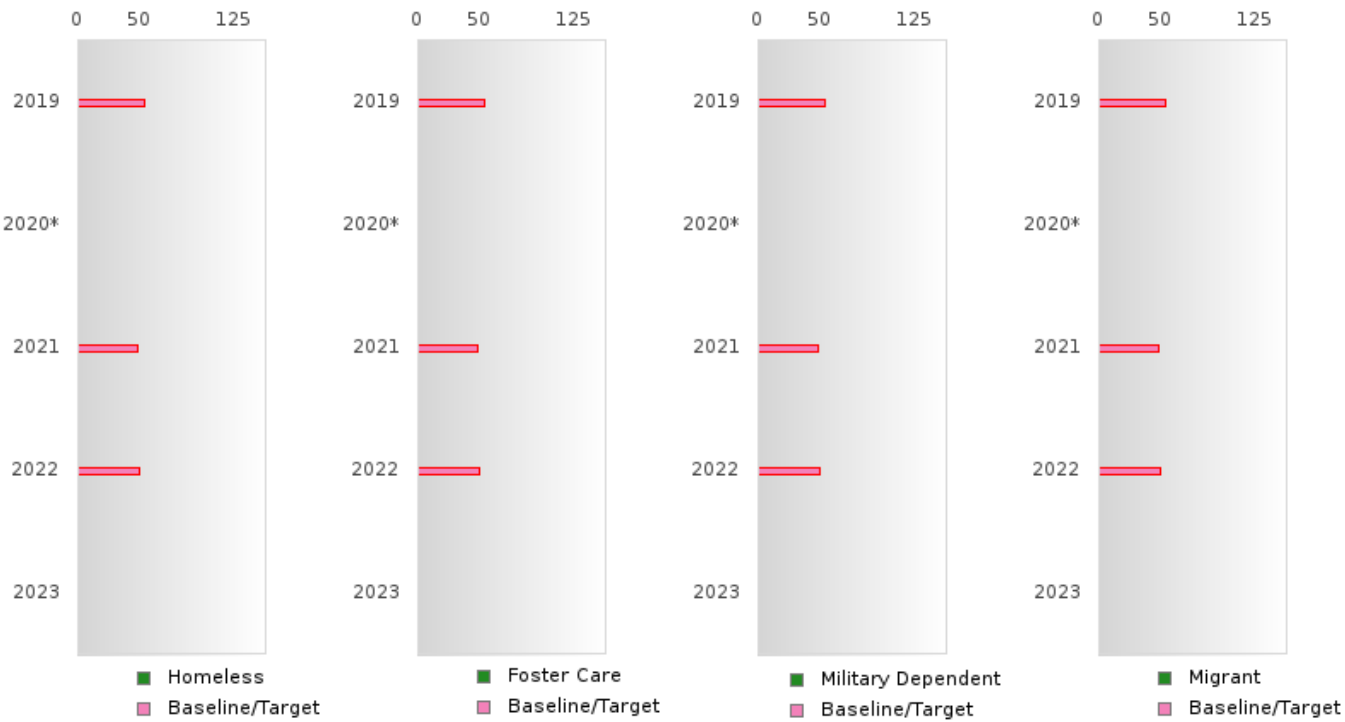

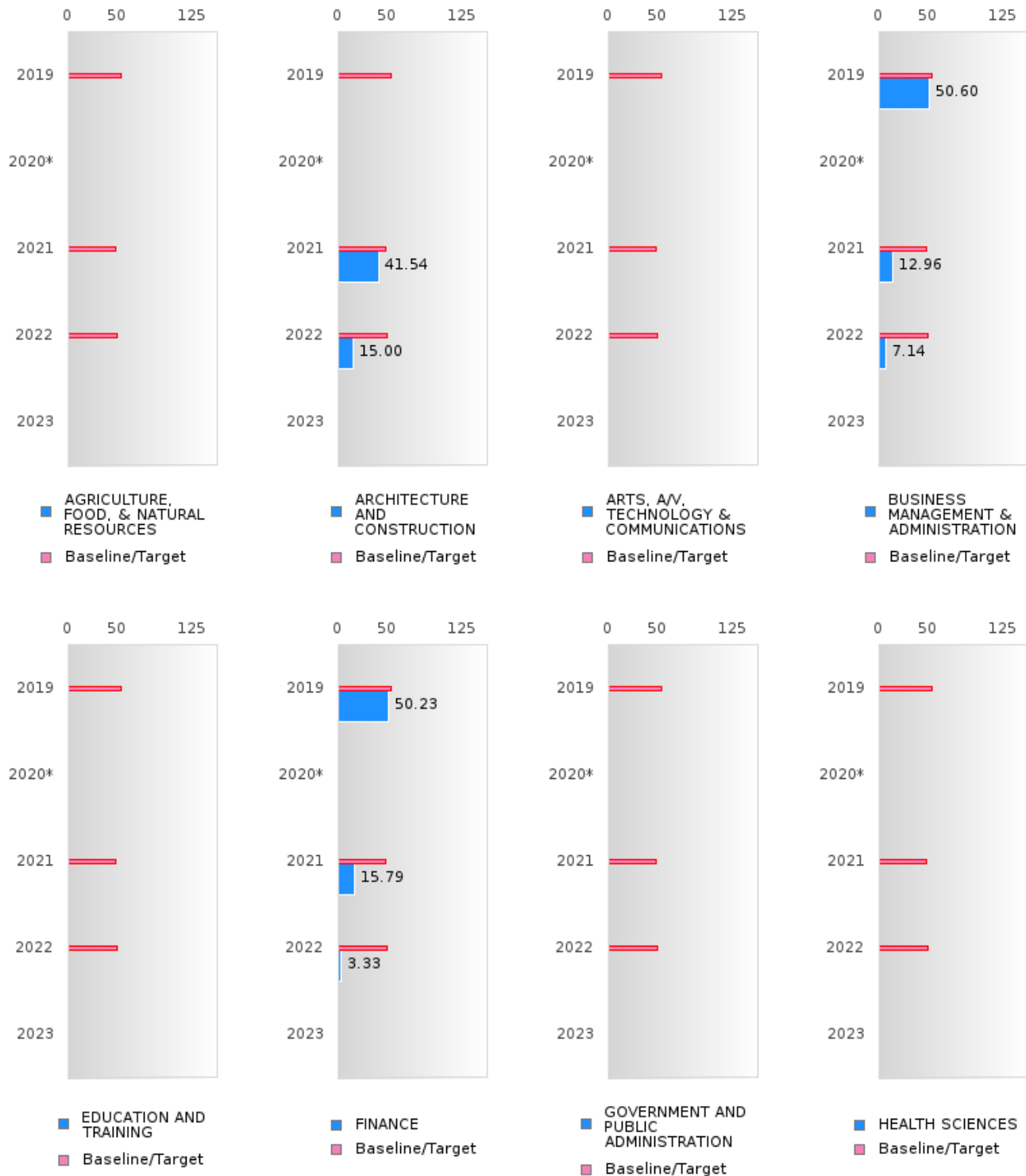

### ACADEMIC PROFICIENCY SCORE IN READING LANGUAGE ARTS BY CLUSTER



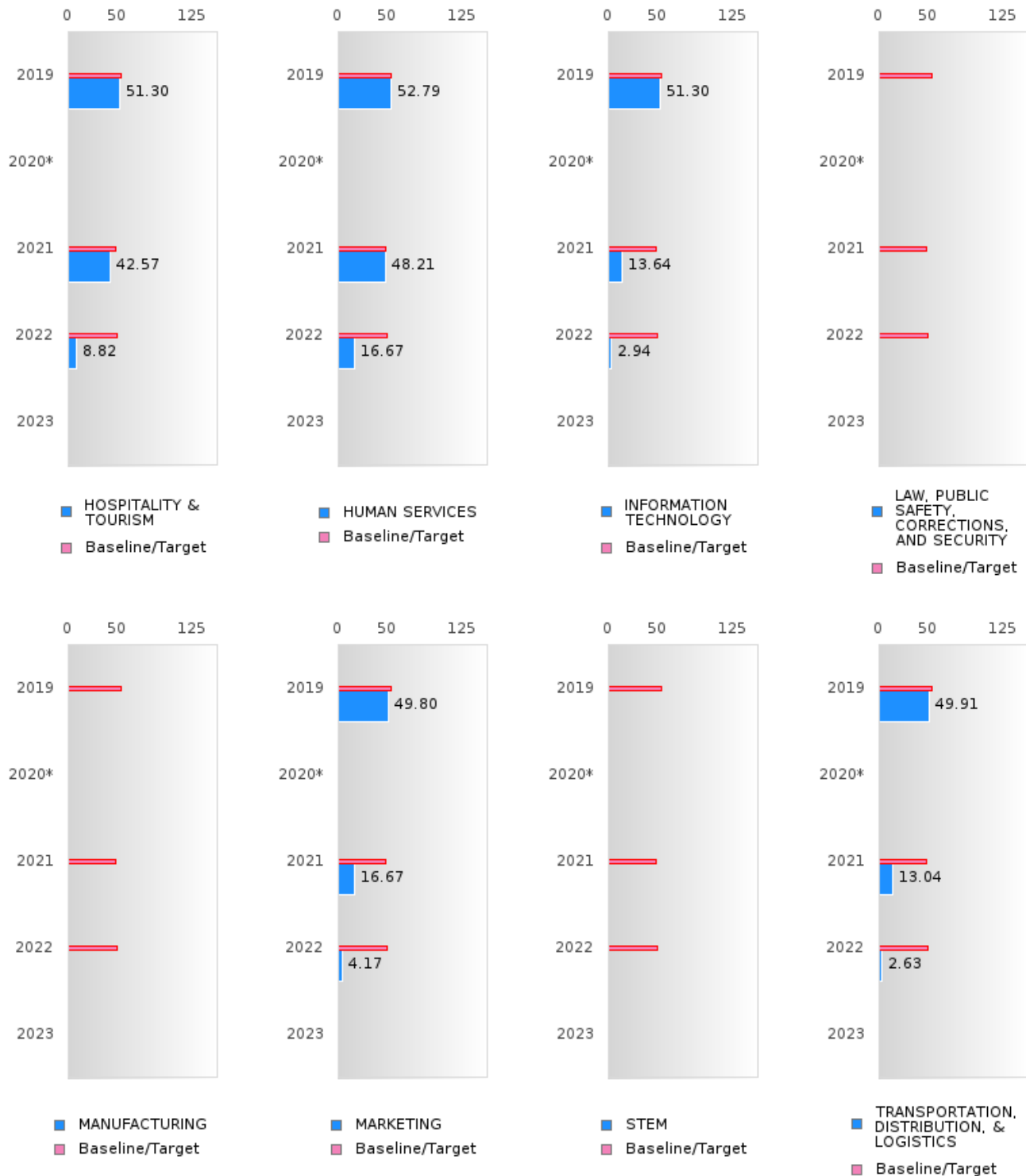

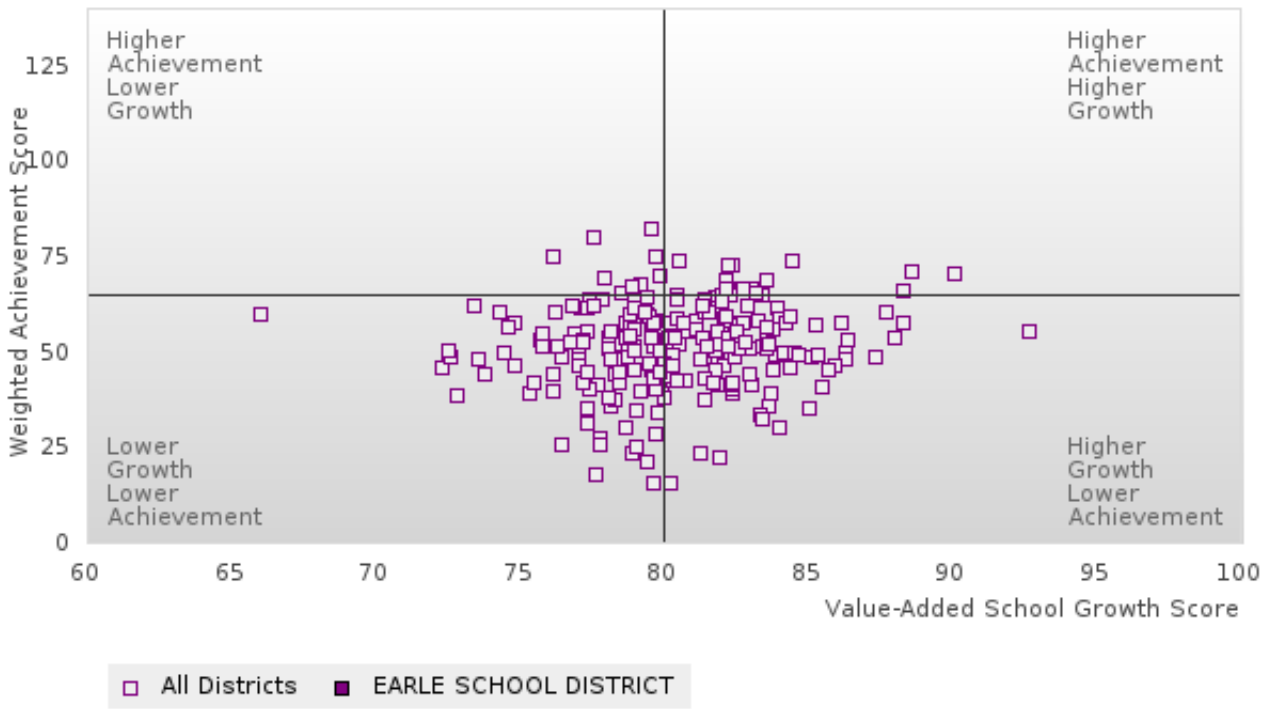

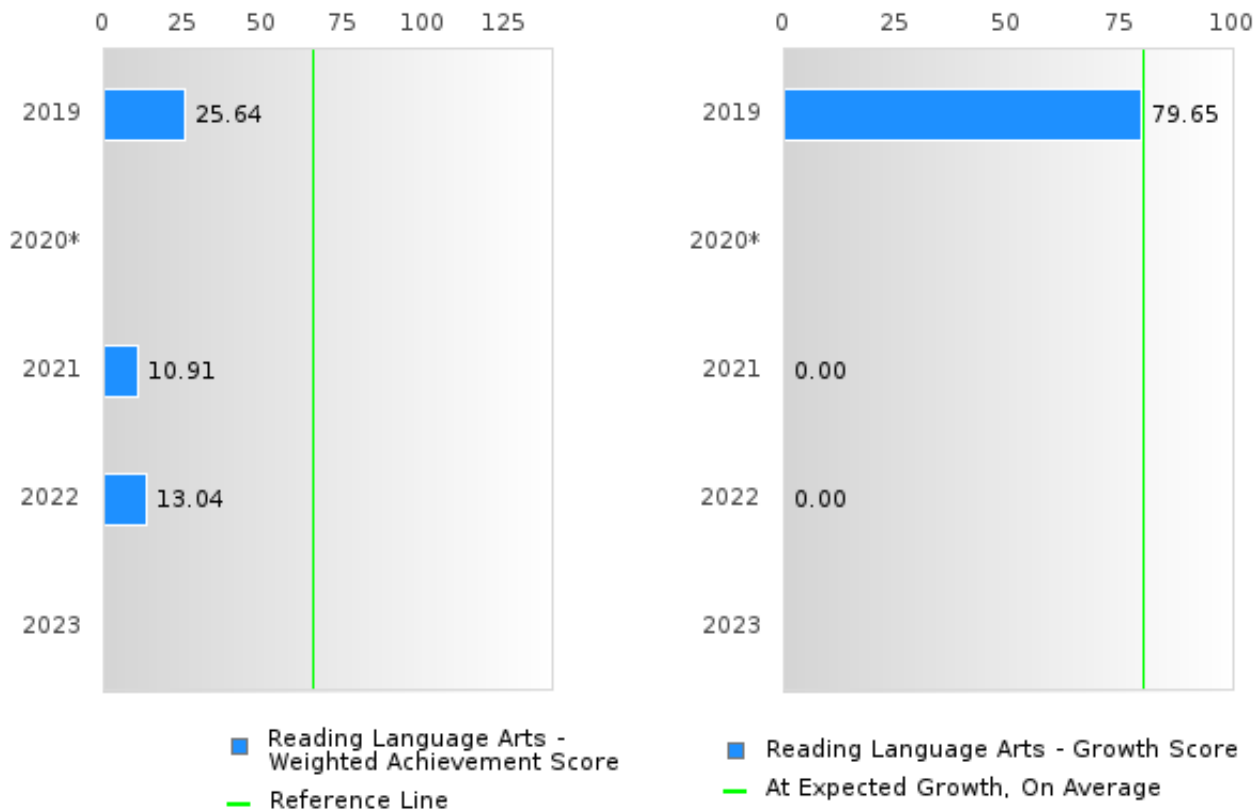

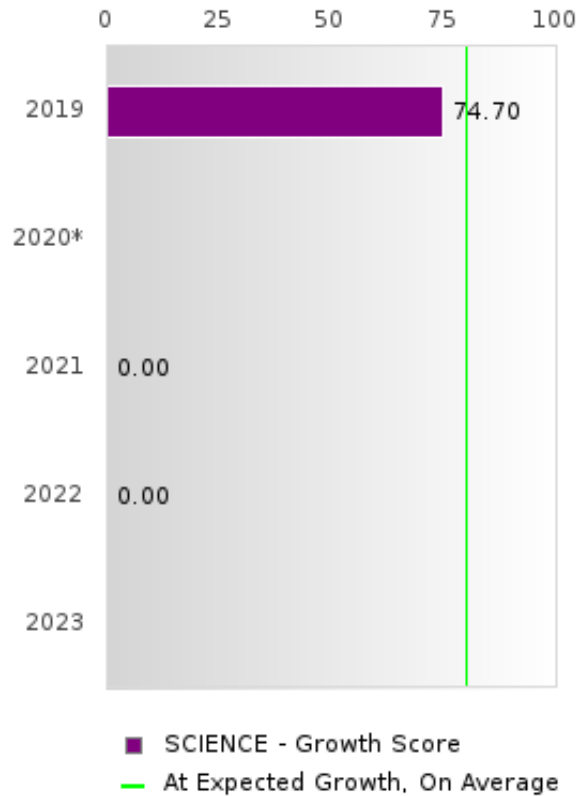

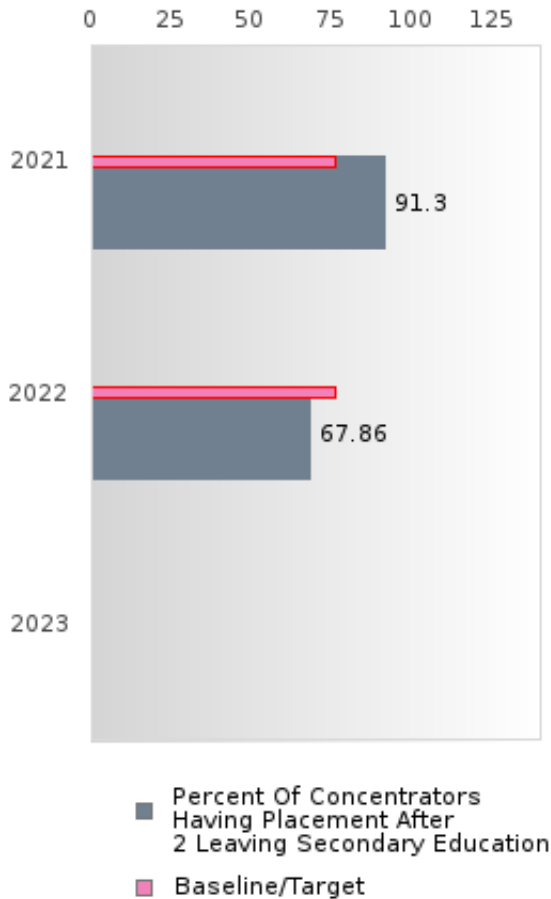

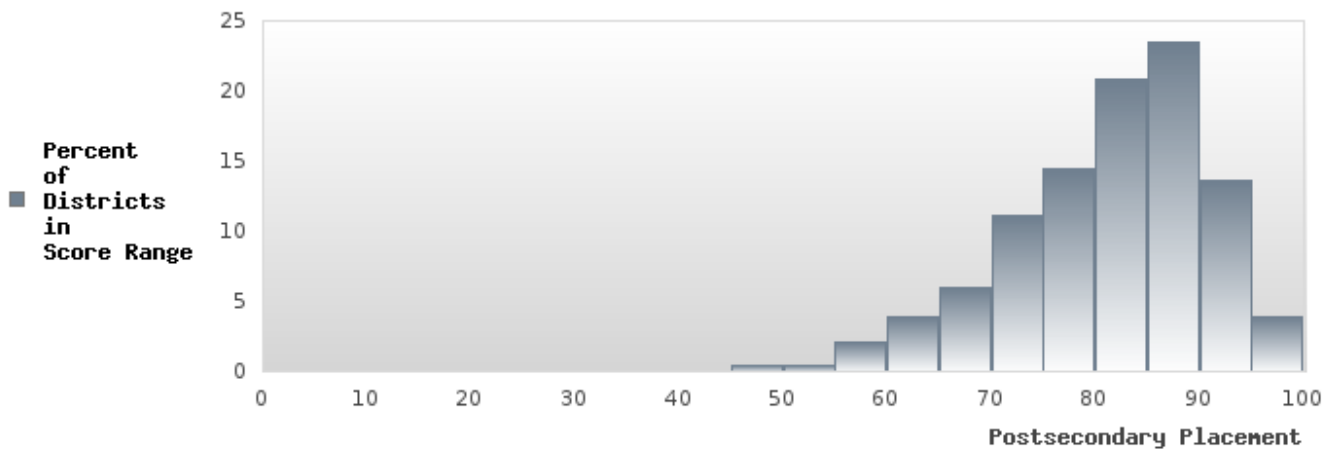

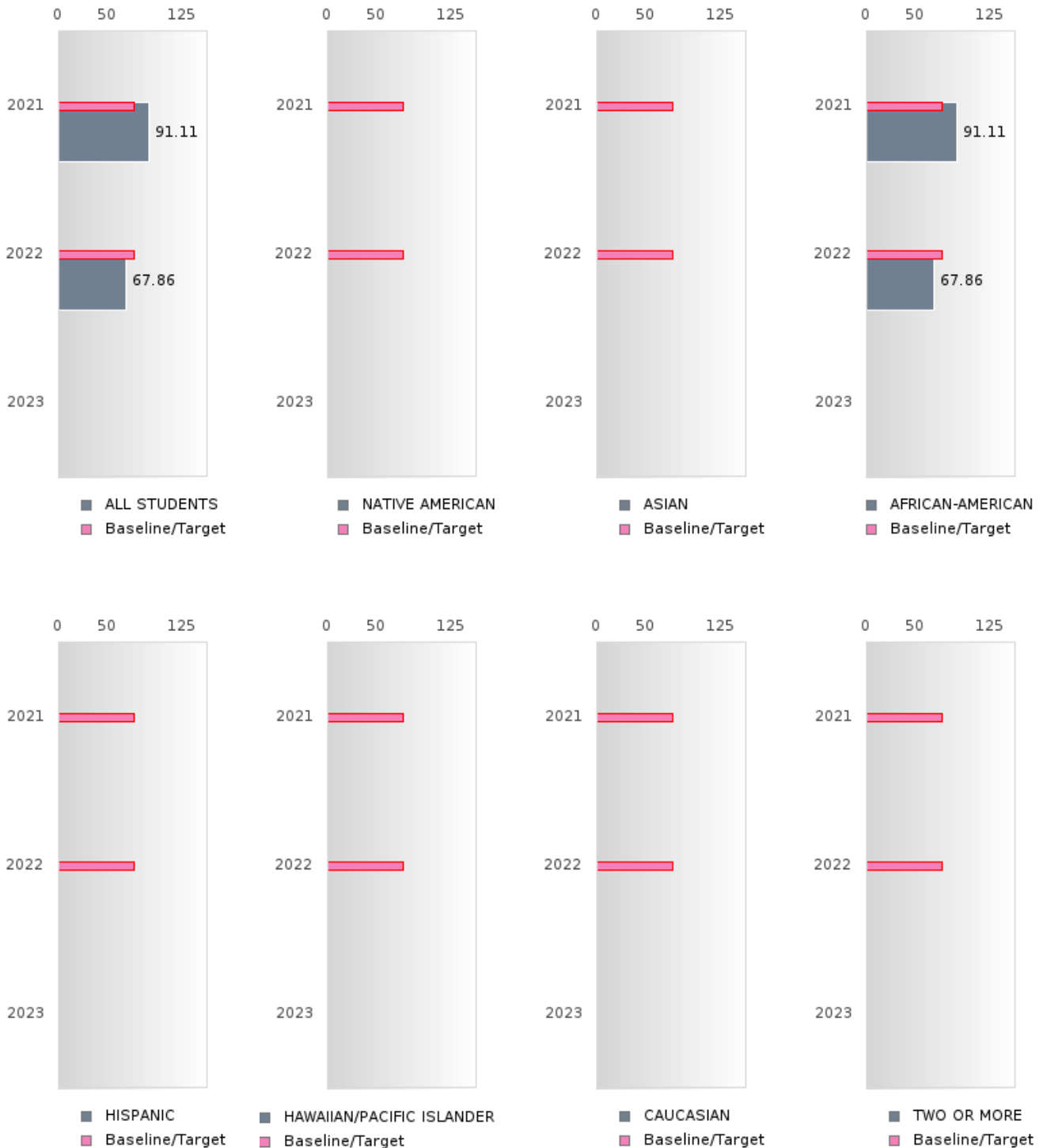
### DISTRIBUTION OF DISTRICT POSTSECONDARY PLACEMENT PERCENT

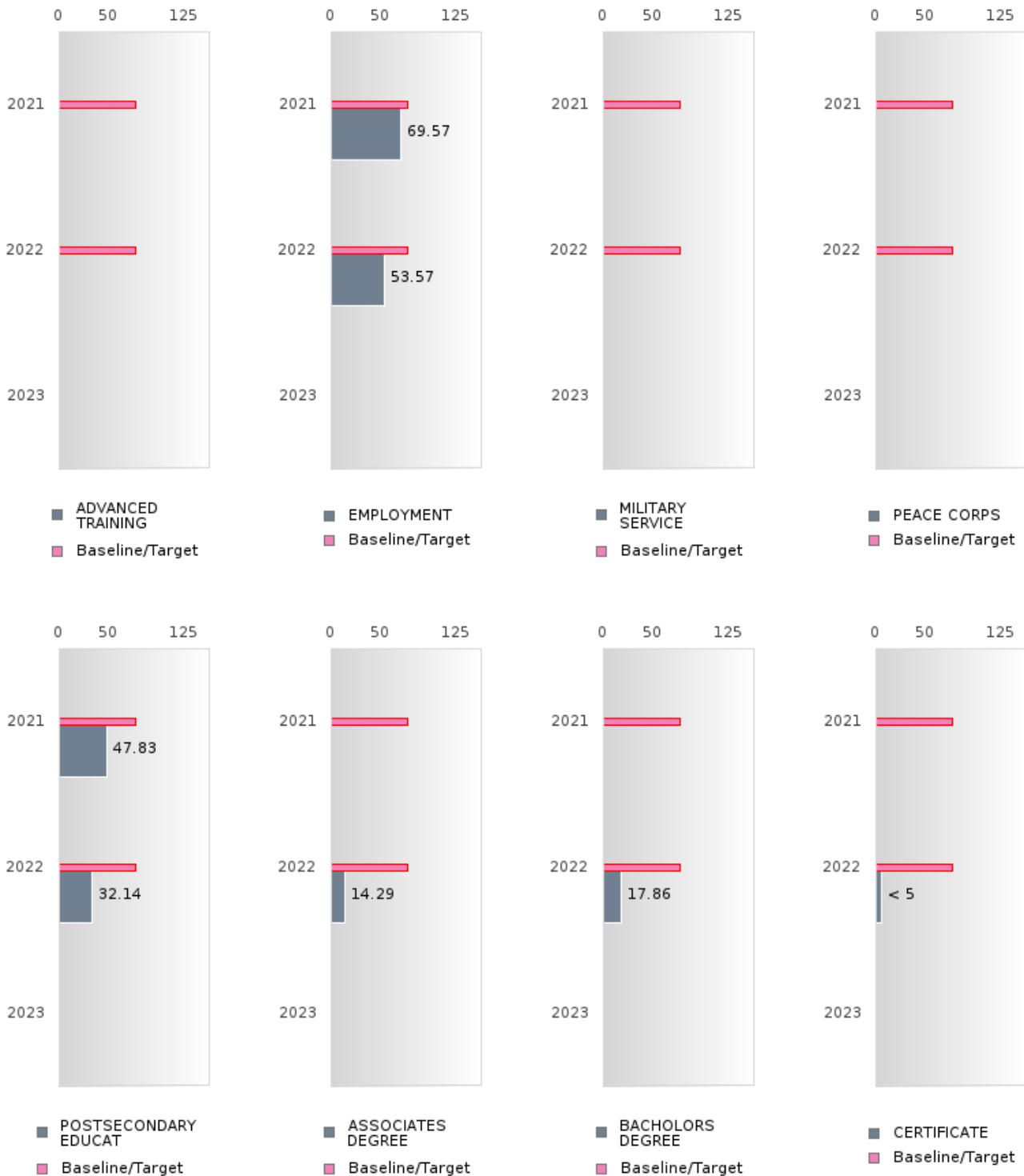

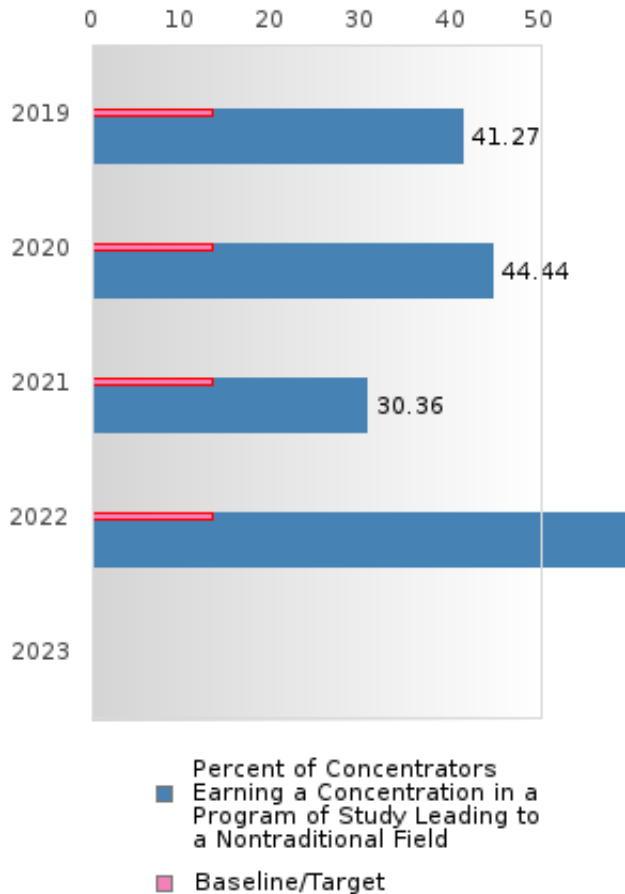

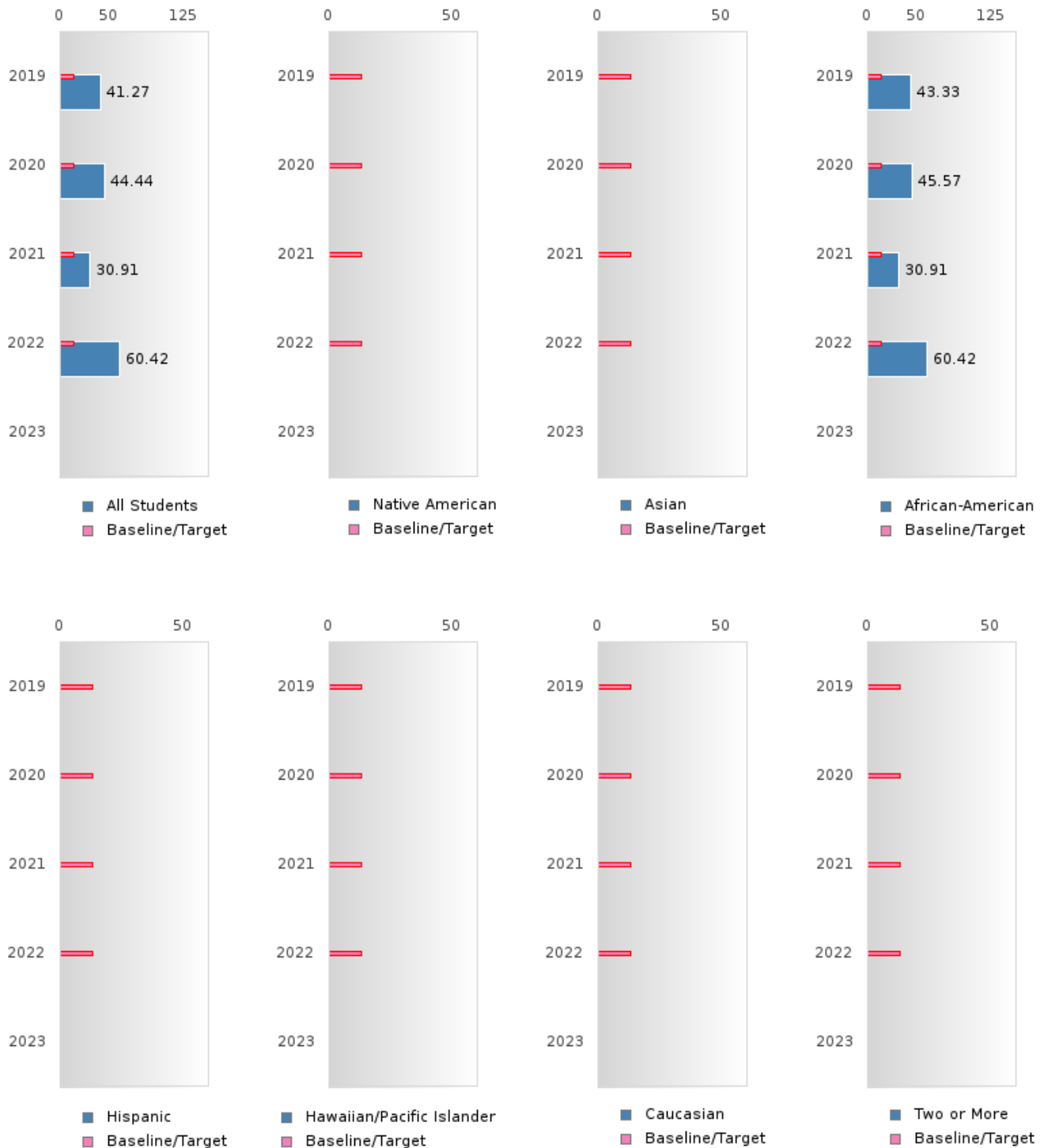
### DISTRIBUTION OF DISTRICT NON-TRADITIONAL PROGRAM PERCENT

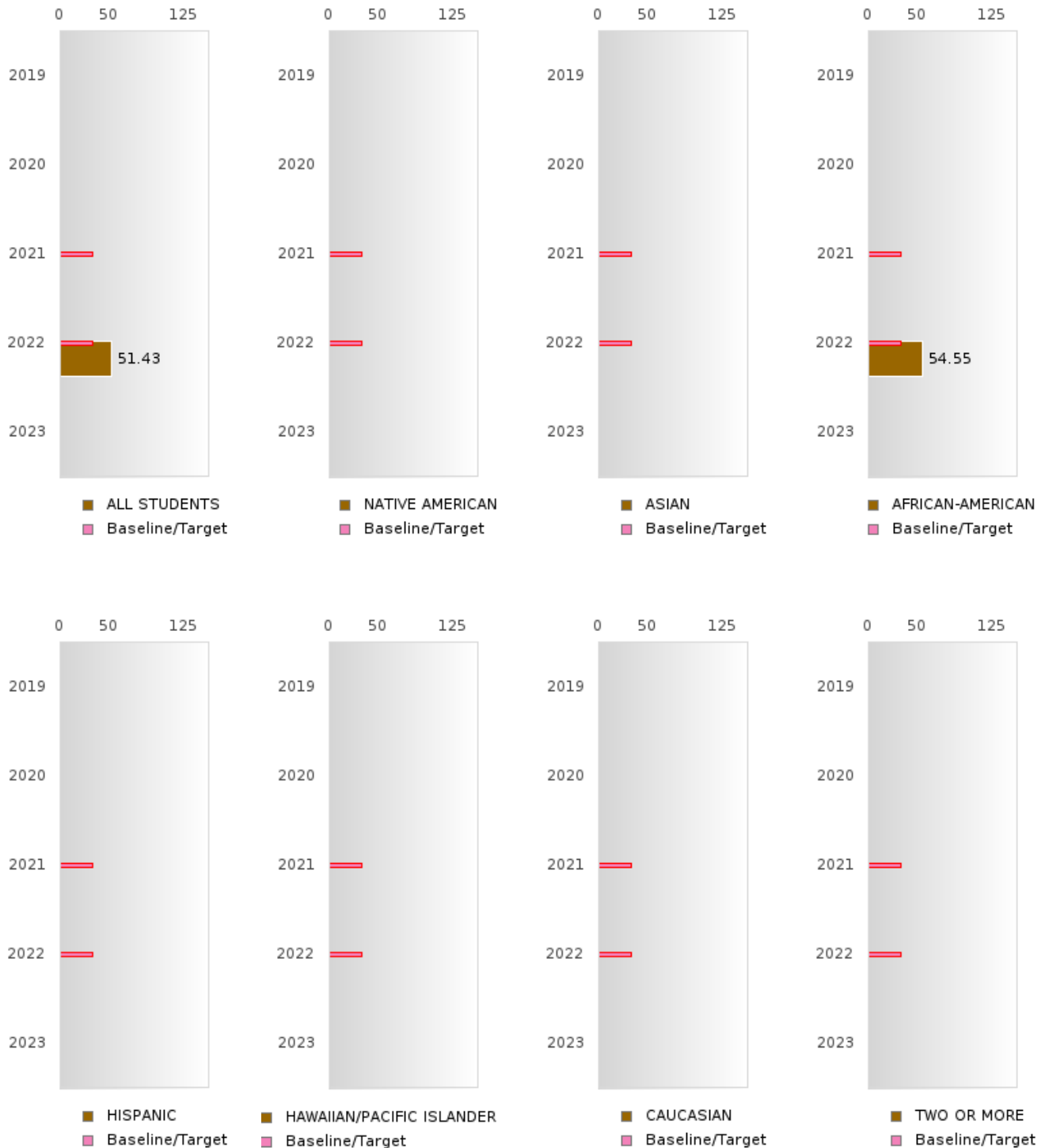
### DISTRIBUTION OF DISTRICT RECONGIZED POSTSECONDARY CREDENTIAL PERCENT

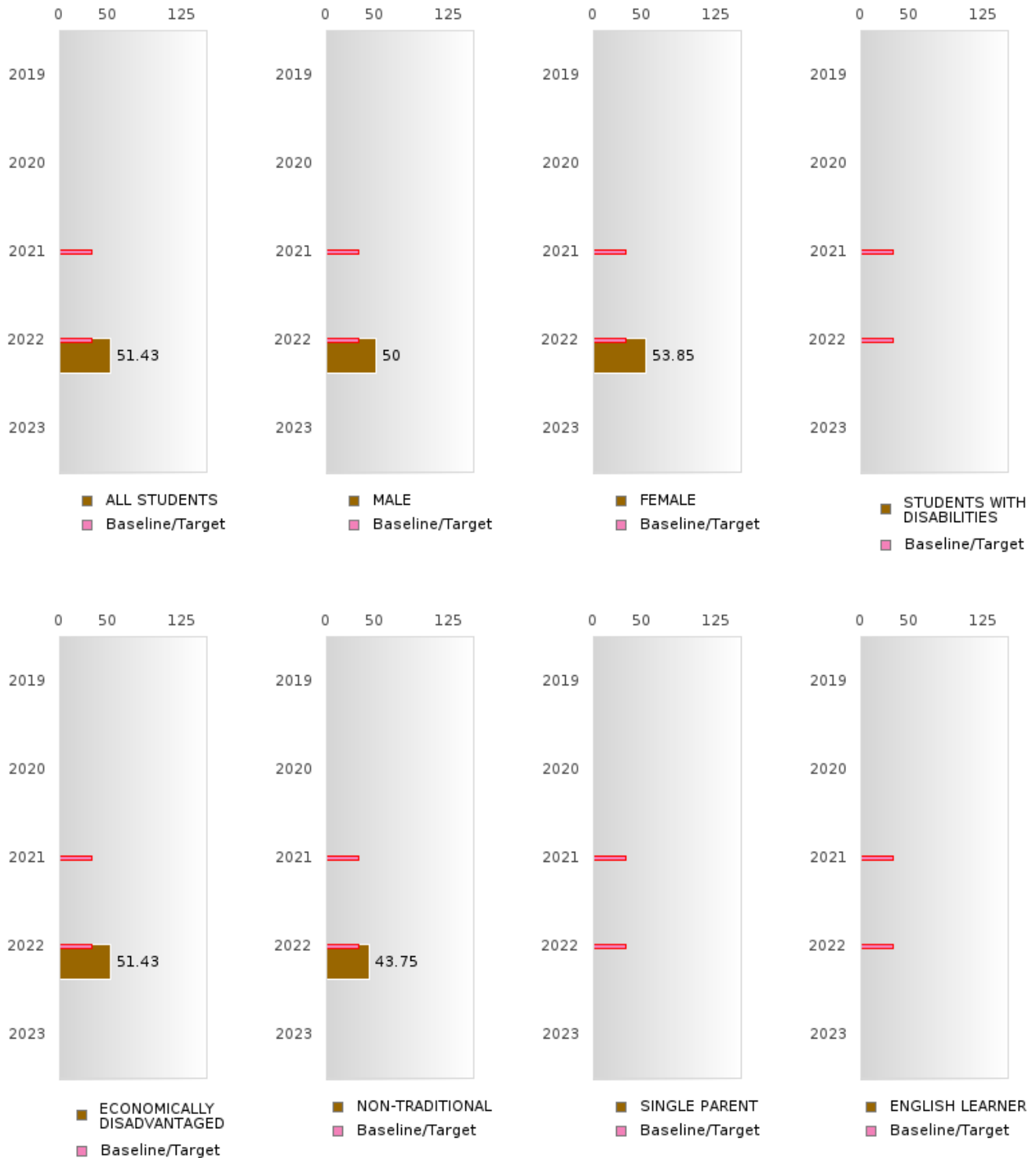

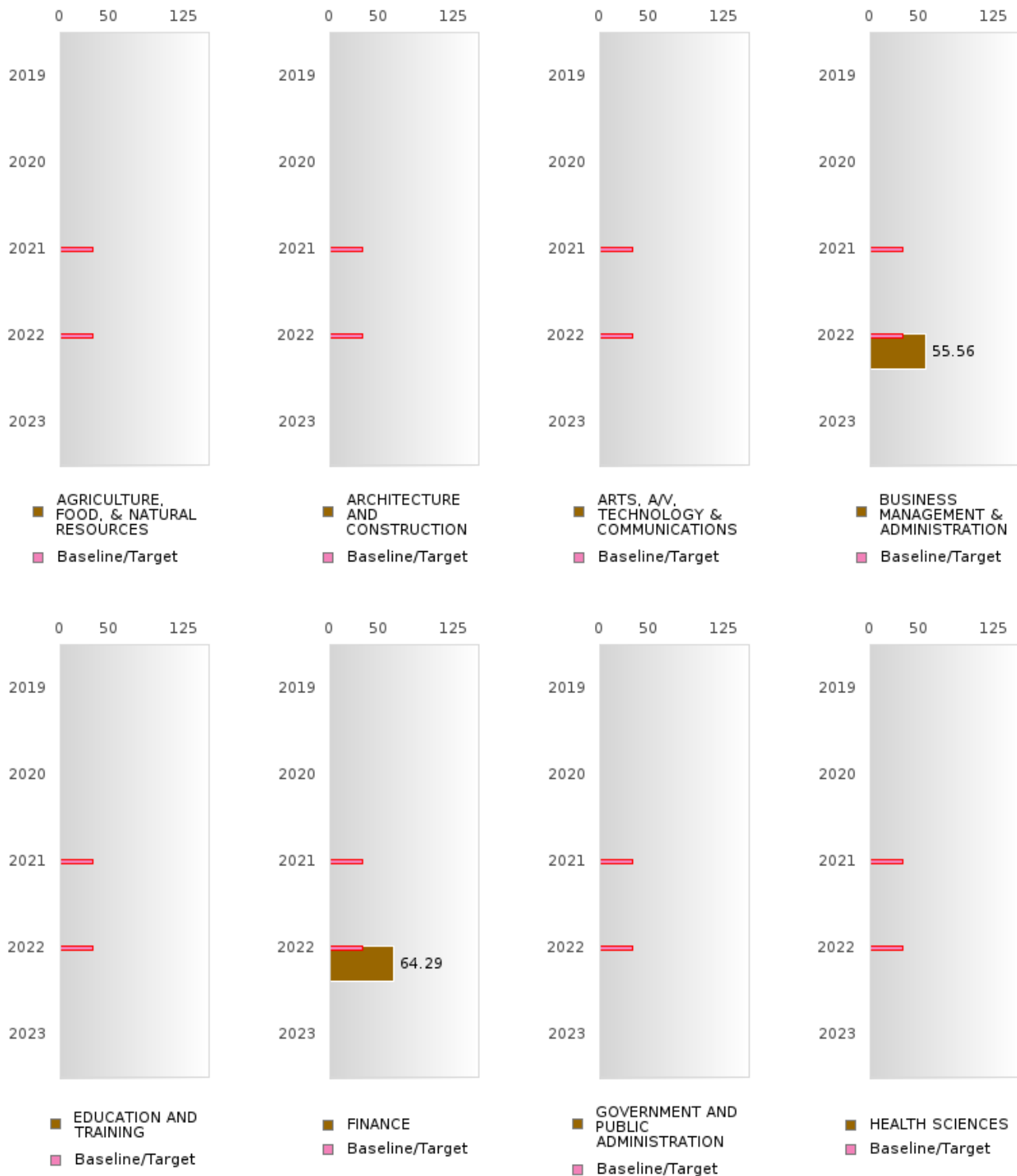

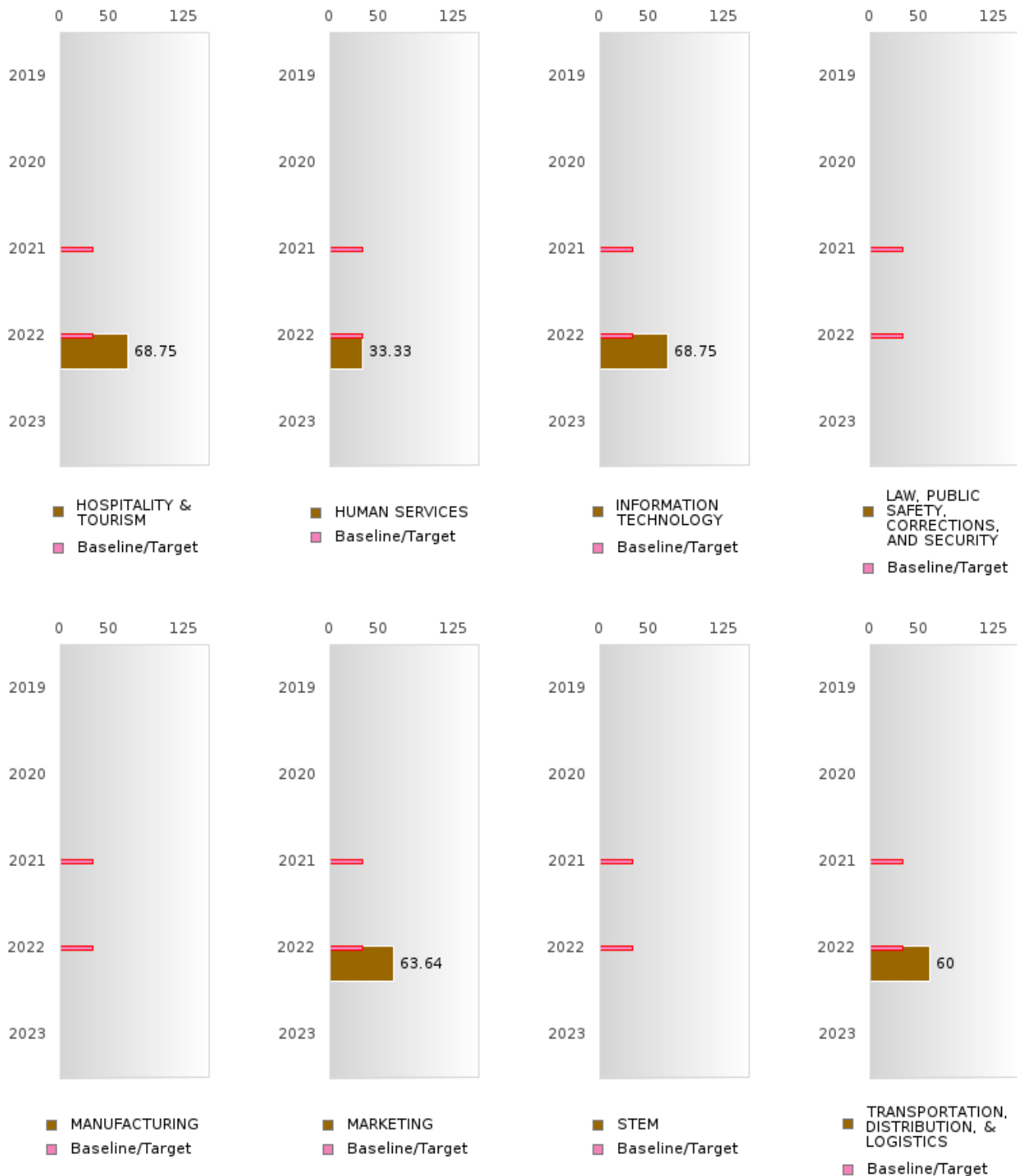
