**Non-Concentrator** -All other students. Non-concentrators may include students who have completed one or more CTE credits that were not within the same program of study or in the progressive levels of specificity. Non-concentrators may include students who have never completed a CTE credit.

Students included in these reports are Grades 9 - 12 students actively enrolled as indicated in 2022-23 school year SIS Cycle 7 who have earned a concentration in one or more programs of study. 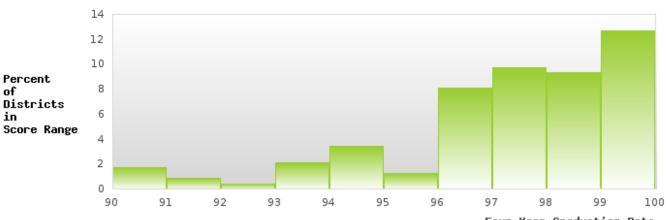














#### DISTRIBUTION OF DISTRICT SCORES FOR ACADEMIC PROFICIENCY IN READING LANGUAGE ARTS

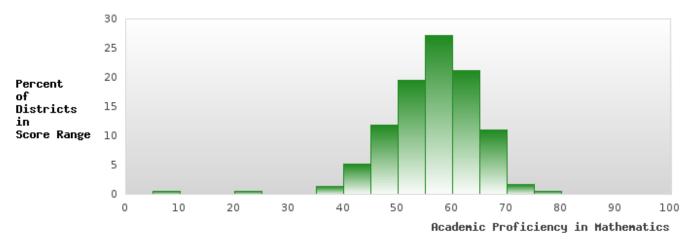







#### DISTRIBUTION OF DISTRICT SCORES FOR ACADEMIC PROFICIENCY IN SCIENCE





#### ACADEMIC PROFICIENCY SCORE IN READING LANGUAGE ARTS BY RACE/ETHNICITY







#### SCATTERPLOT OF WEIGHTED ACHIEVEMENT & VALUE-ADDED GROWTH FOR MATHEMATICS








































