Any two levels must sum to two (2) credits within a program of study. Concentrators must have 1.0 credit in Level 1. Level 1 includes the foundational courses. Levels progress in specificity as required (Section 3(41)(D-E)).

**Non-Concentrator** -All other students. Non-concentrators may include students who have completed one or more CTE credits that were not within the same program of study or in the progressive levels of specificity. Non-concentrators may include students who have never completed a CTE credit.

#### Who is included in these reports?

Students included in these reports are Grades 9 - 12 students actively enrolled as indicated in 2022-23 school year SIS Cycle 7 who have earned a concentration in one or more programs of study. Credits may be earned starting in Grade 7 through Grade 12. An example for 2023 concentrators is provided below.





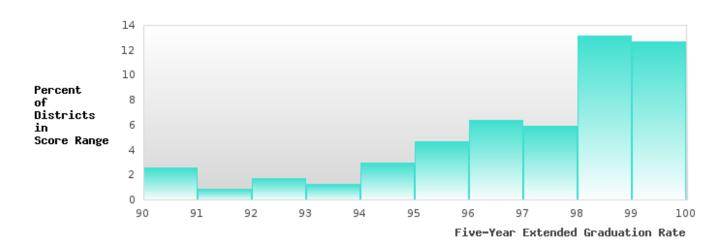





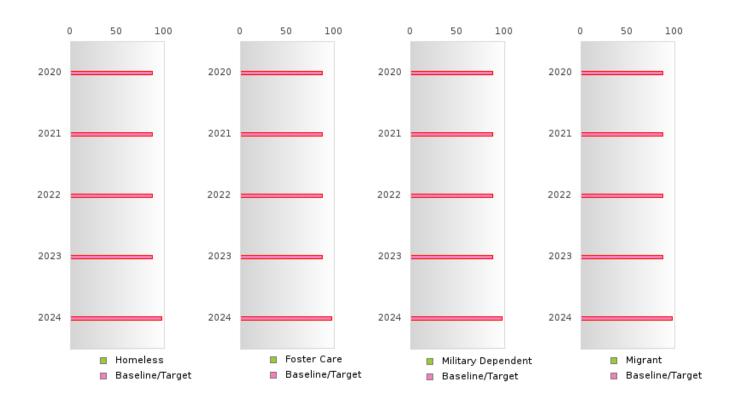



### ACADEMIC PROFICIENCY SCORE IN READING LANGUAGE ARTS



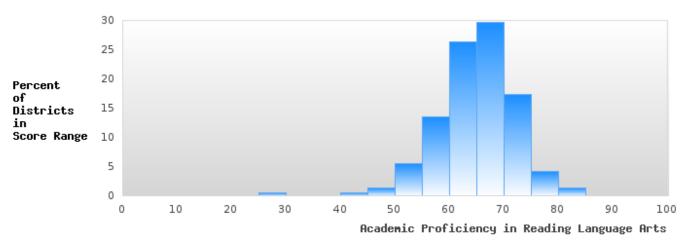


Academic Proficiency in Reading Language Arts Baseline/Target





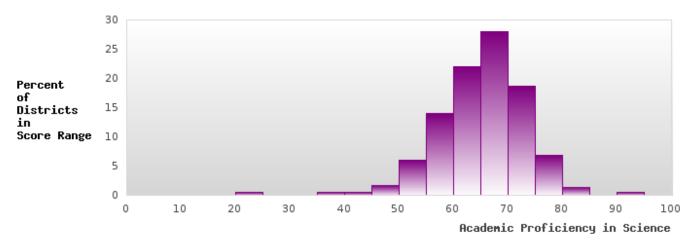

#### DISTRIBUTION OF DISTRICT SCORES FOR ACADEMIC PROFICIENCY IN SCIENCE





### ACADEMIC PROFICIENCY SCORE IN READING LANGUAGE ARTS BY RACE/ETHNICITY







### ACADEMIC PROFICIENCY SCORE IN READING LANGUAGE ARTS BY SPECIAL POPULATION





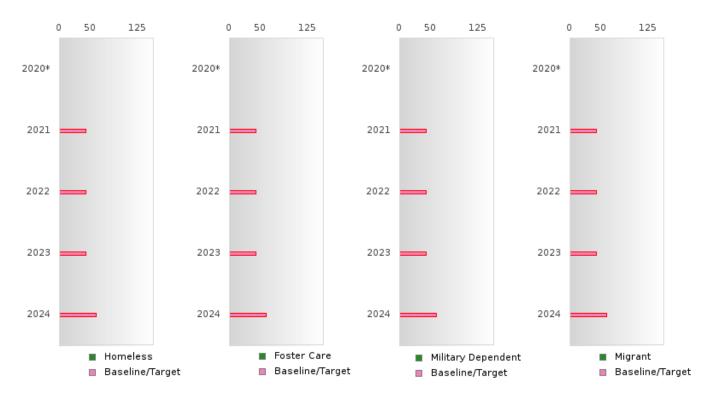



#### SCATTERPLOT OF WEIGHTED ACHIEVEMENT & VALUE-ADDED GROWTH FOR MATHEMATICS

















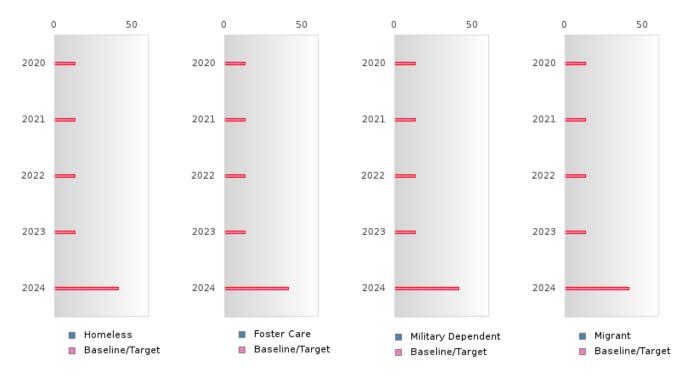






Percent of Graduated Concentrators Earning a Recognized Postsecondary Credential 🔲 Baseline/Target



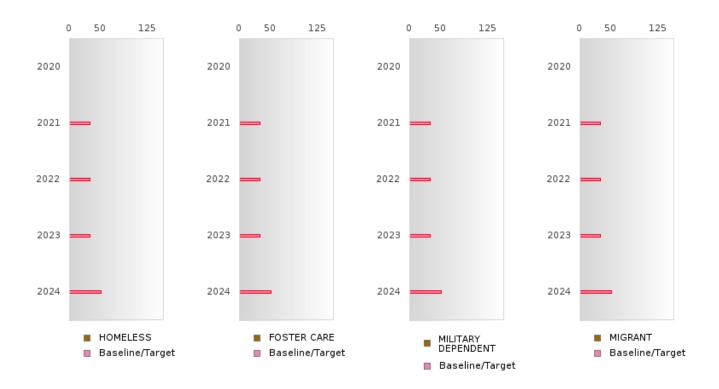


