

Non-Concentrator -All other students. Non-concentrators may include students who have completed one or more CTE credits that were not within the same program of study or in the progressive levels of specificity. Non-concentrators may include students who have never completed a CTE credit.

Who is included in these reports?

Students included in these reports are Grades 9 – 12 students actively enrolled as indicated in 2020-21 school year SIS Cycle 7 who have earned a concentration in one or more program of study. Credits may be earned starting in Grade 7 through Grade 12. An example for 2021 concentrators is provided below.







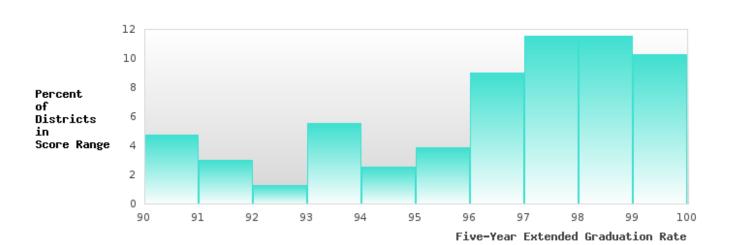


DISTRIBUTION OF DISTRICT FIVE-YEAR EXTENDED ADJUSTED COHORT GRADUATION RATES




CONSORTIUM FOUR-YEAR ADJUSTED COHORT GRADUATION RATE BY CLUSTER

The Academic Proficiency Performance Measures (Reading/Language Arts [1S1]; Mathematics [1S2]; Science [1S3]) in Arkansas's approved Perkins V plan are designed to align with the achievement and growth measures in Arkansas's approved ESSA plan. This alignment provides schools with a unified focus on increased rigor and relevance in student learning opportunities within a student-focused learning system to improve academic proficiency and increase students' readiness for college, career, and community engagement.





DISTRIBUTION OF DISTRICT SCORES FOR ACADEMIC PROFICIENCY IN READING **LANGUAGE ARTS**





DISTRIBUTION OF DISTRICT SCORES FOR ACADEMIC PROFICIENCY IN MATHEMATICS





DISTRIBUTION OF DISTRICT SCORES FOR ACADEMIC PROFICIENCY IN SCIENCE




ACADEMIC PROFICIENCY SCORE IN READING LANGUAGE ARTS BY RACE/ETHNICITY


ACADEMIC PROFICIENCY SCORE IN MATHEMATICS BY RACE/ETHNICITY






ACADEMIC PROFICIENCY SCORE IN MATHEMATICS BY SPECIAL POPULATION




ACADEMIC PROFICIENCY SCORE IN READING LANGUAGE ARTS BY CLUSTER







SCATTERPLOT OF WEIGHTED ACHIEVEMENT & VALUE-ADDED GROWTH FOR READING LANGUAGE ARTS




SCATTERPLOT OF WEIGHTED ACHIEVEMENT & VALUE-ADDED GROWTH FOR MATHEMATICS


SCATTERPLOT OF WEIGHTED ACHIEVEMENT & VALUE-ADDED GROWTH FOR SCIENCE















DISTRIBUTION OF DISTRICT POSTSECONDARY PLACEMENT PERCENT








DISTRIBUTION OF DISTRICT NON-TRADITIONAL PROGRAM PERCENT







PERCENT OF GRADUATED CONCENTRATORS EARNING A RECONGIZED POSTSECONDARY CREDENTIAL










