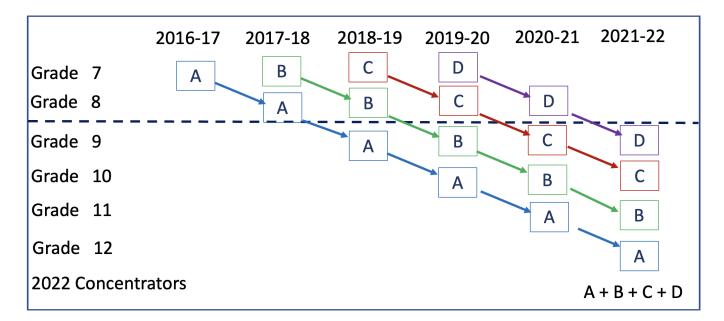

Levels progress in specificity as required (Section 3(41)(D-E)).

**Non-Concentrator** -All other students. Non-concentrators may include students who have completed one or more CTE credits that were not within the same program of study or in the progressive levels of specificity. Non-concentrators may include students who have never completed a CTE credit.

#### Who is included in these reports?

Students included in these reports are Grades 9 – 12 students actively enrolled as indicated in 2020-21 school year SIS Cycle 7 who have earned a concentration in one or more program of study. Credits may be earned starting in Grade 7 through Grade 12. An example for 2021 concentrators is provided below.



#### **Data Definitions:**

- The performance measure data in this report are from the 2021-22 school year except for postsecondary placement which is a lagged indicator. The students included in the postsecondary placement performance measure exited high school in the 2020-21 school year.
- Consortium membership and single LEA status are based on the 2021-22 school year.

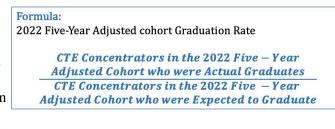



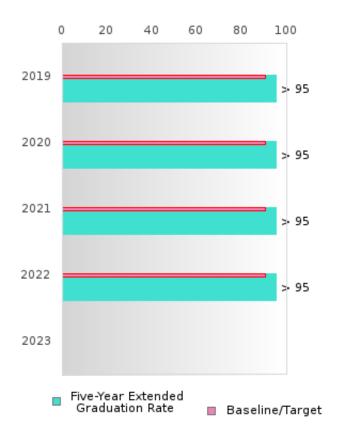
#### DISTRIBUTION OF DISTRICT FOUR-YEAR ADJUSTED COHORT GRADUATION RATES

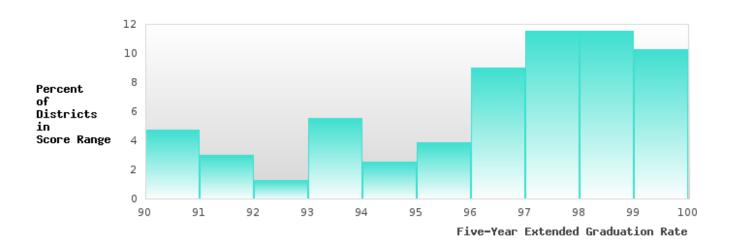





#### CONSORTIUM FOUR-YEAR ADJUSTED COHORT GRADUATION RATE BY CLUSTER





The Academic Proficiency Performance Measures (Reading/Language Arts [1S1]; Mathematics [1S2]; Science [1S3]) in Arkansas's approved Perkins V plan are designed to align with the achievement and growth measures in Arkansas's approved ESSA plan. This alignment provides schools with a unified focus on increased rigor and relevance in student learning opportunities within a student-focused learning system to improve academic proficiency and increase students' readiness for college, career, and community engagement.



#### ACADEMIC PROFICIENCY SCORE IN READING LANGUAGE ARTS






Academic Proficiency in Reading Language Arts Baseline/Target

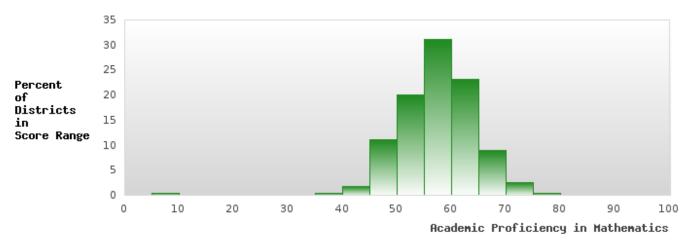



#### DISTRIBUTION OF DISTRICT SCORES FOR ACADEMIC PROFICIENCY IN SCIENCE



#### ACADEMIC PROFICIENCY SCORE IN READING LANGUAGE ARTS BY RACE/ETHNICITY







#### SCATTERPLOT OF WEIGHTED ACHIEVEMENT & VALUE-ADDED GROWTH FOR MATHEMATICS






### SCATTERPLOT OF WEIGHTED ACHIEVEMENT & VALUE-ADDED GROWTH FOR SCIENCE

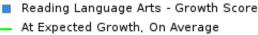





















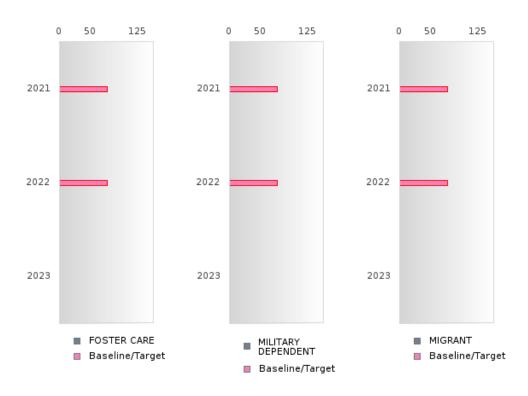












Percent of Graduated Concentrators Earning a Recognized Postsecondary Credential 🛛 Baseline/Target








