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DEFINITIONS:

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CTE Concentrator -A student who has completed one foundational CTE credit and one additional CTE credit for a total of two CTE credits within the same approved CTE program of study. Any two levels must sum to two (2) credits within a program of study. Concentrators must have 1.0 credit in Level 1. Level 1 includes the foundational courses. Levels progress in specificity as required (Section 3(41)(D-E)).

Non-Concentrator -All other students. Non-concentrators may include students who have completed one or more CTE credits that were not within the same program of study or in the progressive levels of specificity. Non-concentrators may include students who have never completed a CTE credit.

Who is included in these reports?

Students included in these reports are Grades 9 - 12 students actively enrolled as indicated in 2022-23 school year SIS Cycle 7 who have earned a concentration in one or more programs of study. Credits may be earned starting in Grade 7 through Grade 12. An example for 2023 concentrators is provided below.

GRADUATION PERFORMANCE MEASURES [1S1, 1S2]

MARION SCHOOL DISTRICT

Performance Measures for Graduation Rate consist of a Four-Year Adjusted Cohort Graduation Rate (1S1) and a Five-Year Extended Adjusted Cohort Graduation Rate (1S2). In both cases, only concentrators are included in the measure and concentrators are only counted once.

Four-Year Adjusted Cohort Graduation Rate [1S1]

- Numerator: The percentage of CTE concentrators who graduate high school, as measured by the fouryear adjusted cohort graduation rate (defined in section 8101 of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965).
- Denominator: Number of CTE concentrators who, in the reporting year, were included in the State's computation of its graduation rate as defined in the State's Consolidated Accountability Plan pursuant to Section 1111(b)(2) of the ESSA.









CONSORTIUM FOUR-YEAR ADJUSTED COHORT GRADUATION RATE BY SPECIAL POPULATION





ACADEMIC PERFORMANCE MEASURES [2S1, 2S2, 2S3]

The Academic Proficiency Performance Measures (Reading/Language Arts [1S1]; Mathematics [1S2]; Science [1S3]) in Arkansas's approved Perkins V plan are designed to align with the achievement and growth measures in Arkansas's approved ESSA plan. This alignment provides schools with a unified focus on increased rigor and relevance in student learning opportunities within a student-focused learning system to improve academic proficiency and increase students' readiness for college, career, and community engagement.

The Academic Performance Measures include concentrators that are full academic year students: students who are continuously enrolled in a particular school on or before October 1 through the date of the first data pull for the regular or alternate assessment.

Assessments Included: Act Aspire (Grades 9 - 10) • Dynamic Learning Maps (Grades 9 - 10) • ACT (Grades 11 -12 [3-yr best])

Academic Proficiency Score Calculation:

- Weighted Achievement (Grades 9 12) and Value-Added Growth Scores (Grades 9 -10) Included in Score
- Reading/Language Arts, Mathematics, and Science calculated separately
- Calculated for all schools with Grades 9, 10, 11, and/or 12






Academic Proficiency in Reading Language Arts Baseline/Target









DISTRIBUTION OF CONSORTIA AND SINGLE LEA SCORES FOR ACADEMIC PROFICIENCY IN SCIENCE





ACADEMIC PROFICIENCY SCORE IN READING LANGUAGE ARTS BY RACE/ETHNICITY













SCATTERPLOT OF WEIGHTED ACHIEVEMENT & VALUE-ADDED GROWTH FOR READING LANGUAGE ARTS




SCATTERPLOT OF WEIGHTED ACHIEVEMENT & VALUE-ADDED GROWTH FOR MATHEMATICS





























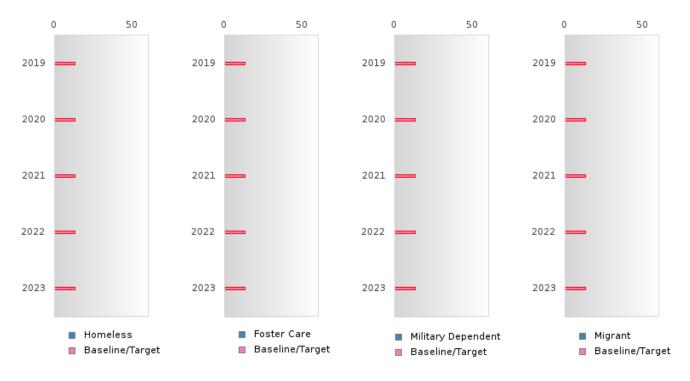




Percent of Graduated Concentrators Earning a Recognized Postsecondary Credential 📋 Baseline/Target






