

### Who is included in these reports?

Students included in these reports are Grades 9 – 12 students actively enrolled as indicated in 2022-23 school year SIS Cycle 7 who have earned a concentration in one or more programs of study. Credits may be earned starting in Grade 7 through Grade 12. An example for 2023 concentrators is provided below.



#### **Data Definitions:**

- The performance measure data in this report are from the 2022-23 school year except for postsecondary placement which is a lagged indicator. The students included in the postsecondary placement performance measure exited high school in the 2021-22 school year.

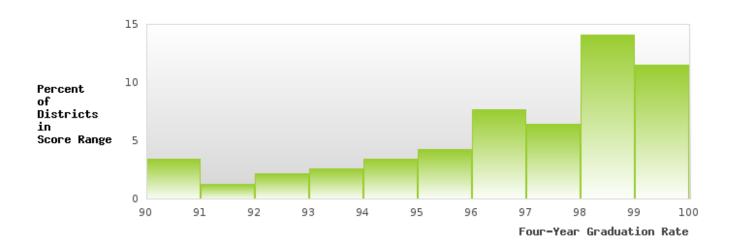
#### CONSORTIUM FOUR-YEAR ADJUSTED COHORT GRADUATION RATE



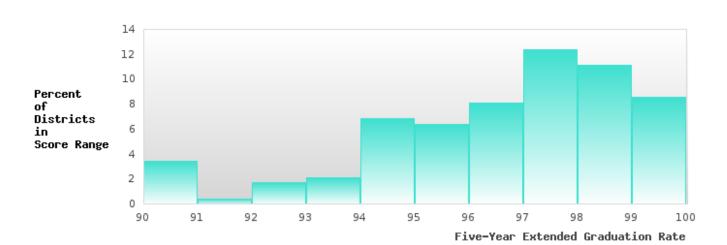





#### CONSORTIUM FOUR-YEAR ADJUSTED COHORT GRADUATION RATE BY CLUSTER








#### ACADEMIC PROFICIENCY SCORE IN READING LANGUAGE ARTS


### DISTRIBUTION OF DISTRICT SCORES FOR ACADEMIC PROFICIENCY IN READING LANGUAGE ARTS

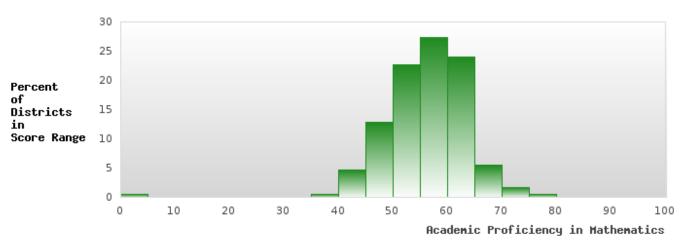


### DISTRIBUTION OF DISTRICT SCORES FOR ACADEMIC PROFICIENCY IN MATHEMATICS




#### DISTRIBUTION OF DISTRICT SCORES FOR ACADEMIC PROFICIENCY IN SCIENCE


#### ACADEMIC PROFICIENCY SCORE IN READING LANGUAGE ARTS BY RACE/ETHNICITY


#### ACADEMIC PROFICIENCY SCORE IN MATHEMATICS BY RACE/ETHNICITY






#### ACADEMIC PROFICIENCY SCORE IN READING LANGUAGE ARTS BY CLUSTER


#### ACADEMIC PROFICIENCY SCORE IN MATHEMATICS BY CLUSTER



### SCATTERPLOT OF WEIGHTED ACHIEVEMENT & VALUE-ADDED GROWTH FOR MATHEMATICS



























## PERCENT OF GRADUATED CONCENTRATORS EARNING A RECONGIZED POSTSECONDARY CREDENTIAL














