

Students included in these reports are Grades 9 – 12 students actively enrolled as indicated in 2022-23 school year SIS Cycle 7 who have earned a concentration in one or more programs of study. Credits may be earned starting in Grade 7 through Grade 12. An example for 2023 concentrators is provided below.




CONSORTIUM FOUR-YEAR ADJUSTED COHORT GRADUATION RATE









CONSORTIUM FOUR-YEAR ADJUSTED COHORT GRADUATION RATE BY CLUSTER








ACADEMIC PROFICIENCY SCORE IN READING LANGUAGE ARTS


DISTRIBUTION OF DISTRICT SCORES FOR ACADEMIC PROFICIENCY IN READING LANGUAGE ARTS




DISTRIBUTION OF DISTRICT SCORES FOR ACADEMIC PROFICIENCY IN MATHEMATICS




DISTRIBUTION OF DISTRICT SCORES FOR ACADEMIC PROFICIENCY IN SCIENCE


ACADEMIC PROFICIENCY SCORE IN READING LANGUAGE ARTS BY RACE/ETHNICITY


ACADEMIC PROFICIENCY SCORE IN MATHEMATICS BY RACE/ETHNICITY




ACADEMIC PROFICIENCY SCORE IN READING LANGUAGE ARTS BY SPECIAL POPULATION


ACADEMIC PROFICIENCY SCORE IN MATHEMATICS BY SPECIAL POPULATION






ACADEMIC PROFICIENCY SCORE IN MATHEMATICS BY CLUSTER







SCATTERPLOT OF WEIGHTED ACHIEVEMENT & VALUE-ADDED GROWTH FOR READING LANGUAGE ARTS




SCATTERPLOT OF WEIGHTED ACHIEVEMENT & VALUE-ADDED GROWTH FOR MATHEMATICS

















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



















PERCENT OF GRADUATED CONCENTRATORS EARNING A RECONGIZED POSTSECONDARY CREDENTIAL









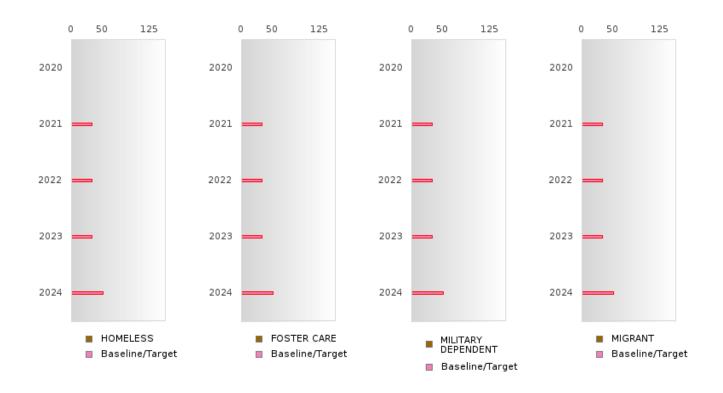




