













CONSORTIUM FOUR-YEAR ADJUSTED COHORT GRADUATION RATE BY CLUSTER





CONSORTIUM FOUR-YEAR ADJUSTED COHORT GRADUATION RATE BY CLUSTER








ACADEMIC PROFICIENCY SCORE IN READING LANGUAGE ARTS


DISTRIBUTION OF DISTRICT SCORES FOR ACADEMIC PROFICIENCY IN READING LANGUAGE ARTS




DISTRIBUTION OF DISTRICT SCORES FOR ACADEMIC PROFICIENCY IN MATHEMATICS




DISTRIBUTION OF DISTRICT SCORES FOR ACADEMIC PROFICIENCY IN SCIENCE


ACADEMIC PROFICIENCY SCORE IN READING LANGUAGE ARTS BY RACE/ETHNICITY


ACADEMIC PROFICIENCY SCORE IN MATHEMATICS BY RACE/ETHNICITY






ACADEMIC PROFICIENCY SCORE IN MATHEMATICS BY SPECIAL POPULATION




ACADEMIC PROFICIENCY SCORE IN READING LANGUAGE ARTS BY CLUSTER









SCATTERPLOT OF WEIGHTED ACHIEVEMENT & VALUE-ADDED GROWTH FOR MATHEMATICS





































PERCENT OF GRADUATED CONCENTRATORS EARNING A RECONGIZED POSTSECONDARY CREDENTIAL




DISTRIBUTION OF DISTRICT RECONGIZED POSTSECONDARY CREDENTIAL PERCENT



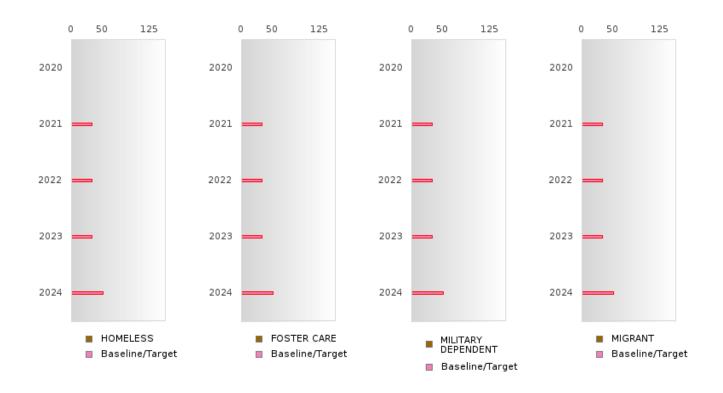




